

## St. Joseph's Corner

The Fifth Sunday of Lent marks the beginning of Passiontide. In these last two weeks of Lent, we prepare by sharpening our focus on Christ's Passion. As we live out Passiontide, our churches cover the crosses and images. All of this is in prepara-

tion for the celebration of the Sacred Triduum.

Why are Crosses and Images Veiled?

The veiling and other Lenten changes to the order of the Mass—like the absence of the Gloria and changing the Gospel Acclimation—help to illustrate our exile from heaven.

## God Loves His People Unceasingly

By the time of the Prophet Jeremiah, God had made four covenants with his people: The Noahic Covenant, The Abrahamic Covenant, the Mosaic Covenant, and the Davidic Covenant. God's chosen people continued to break each covenant and disobey God. Therefore, each new covenant represents God's mercy and love for His chosen people, a new chance for redemption.

Jeremiah foretells the New Covenant—a covenant that will be written into our hearts instead of on stone tablets (Jer. 31:33). This is a covenant of love instead of obligation. We continue to fail to love God fully, yet God's response to our failure is to love us more.

#### Jesus, the Paschal Sacrifice

The New Covenant is instituted at the Last Supper when Jesus proclaims, "This cup, which is poured out for you, is the new covenant in My blood" (Luke 22:20). Jesus is the mediator of the New Covenant. He tells us of the paschal sacrifice He must endure for our sake. He speaks of His death—"this hour" (John 12:27)—and that He came for this purpose.

While preparing for Holy Week, we must reflect on the Paschal Mystery, a doctrine at the core of what it means to be Christian. Christ's work of redemption accomplished principally by his Passion, death, Resurrection, and glorious Ascension, whereby 'dying he destroyed our death, rising he restored our life'" (1067; cf. 654).

#### Our Role in Our Salvation

In the New Covenant, God promises to forgive our sins and accept us in communion with Him if we turn our hearts toward Him. Jesus explains that if the grain of wheat does not fall and die, it remains only a grain of wheat, but if it dies, it will bear much fruit. We, too, must let that which keeps us from God fall from our lives and die (John 12:24).

We are not meant for life in this world. Our tendency to cling to the material nature of this world will ultimately cost us our lives. Jesus tells us to hate the life of this world. If we wish to serve Him, we must follow Him by keeping His commandments and modeling our life after Him.

As husbands and fathers, we must lead our families by example, imitating Christ's life, following His commandments, and letting die the attachments to this world. Only then can we hope to bear fruit in the world to come.

St. Joseph is the foster father of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He's the patron saint of fathers. Joseph is also the <u>protector of the Church</u>. He's one of the patrons of refugees, because he took Mary and Jesus, when Jesus was a baby, to safety in Egypt, to flee the wrath of the tyrannical King Herod. Joseph is also the patron saint of laborers, because he was a working man, a carpenter. He's the patron saint of families and, here's a beautiful one, he's the patron saint of those who are dying.



Saint Patrick was born in England, but when he was a teenager, he was captured by Irish pirates who took him to Ireland as a slave. After six years, Saint Patrick escaped and returned to England and his family.

When Saint Patrick became a priest, he traveled back to Ireland as a missionary so that he could teach the people about God. He used examples to explain the mysteries of the faith in simple ways. One day, Saint Patrick compared the Trinity to a shamrock. He said that the shamrock has three leaves, but it is only one plant. In the same way, God is three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—but one God. God used Saint Patrick's kidnapping to convert the Irish people. In our lives, God uses the bad times to bring about a good we do not always see. We must be patient and trust Him.

## **SUPER BOWL SURPRISE**





ON A SUNDAY IN FEBRUARY, I gathered with my family and friends to watch the Super Bowl. It was entertaining hearing everyone's reasons for gathering around the game that day. Some were cheering on a particular team or player. Others couldn't

wait to view the halftime show or catch a glimpse of Taylor Swift. A few just relished being in the company of friends and family and indulging in the abundance of food and drink. Regardless of each person's motivation, the Super Bowl provided us with an opportunity to come together in the spirit of fun and camaraderie.

I enjoyed the gathering and the game for all those reasons, but I must admit many of the commercials left me confused! I found myself asking, "What was that commercial about?" or, "What product were they trying to sell? I just don't get it!" Thankfully, there were plenty of younger people around to explain curious ads to me.

Then, to my surprise, a 30-second commercial popped up featuring the actors Mark Wahlberg and Jonathan Roumie. I did a double-take and blurted out in surprise, "Wait a minute! Did they just actually run a positive, CATHOLIC commercial?!" I convinced my family and friends to rewind it and rewatch it with me three times. Amazingly, the commercial urged viewers to take a break from the game, thank God, and enjoy a moment of prayer on this Sunday. The ad highlighted a 40-day Lenten prayer challenge to be found on the Hallow app. The last three words in the commercial nudged us to "Stay prayed up." If you have not yet seen this commercial, you can find it on Hallow's YouTube channel (hallow.com/youtube).

I'm already a subscriber to the Hallow app. But I immediately clicked to join the 40-day prayer challenge which began on Ash Wednesday. It seems I was not alone in heeding that call! The day after Ash Wednesday, the Hallow app reached the number-one spot in Apple's App Store. I'm liking this structured and intentional Lenten challenge; it has enhanced my further spiritual growth during this season of Lent.

Here's what's stirred me: the Pray40 Community Prayer Challenge offers a different, well-prepared meditation or reflection from a variety of presenters, including Mark Wahlberg, Jonathan Roumie, Sister Mary Bernice, M.C.; Sister Miriam James, S.O.L.T; and Father Mike Schmitz. Many of the days guide us through the astonishing, spiritual classic, *He Leadeth Me*, written by Fr. Walter J. Ciszek, S.J. Fr. Walter was a Jesuit priest and missionary, imprisoned for more than 20 years in the Soviet Union. Amidst horrific and brutal conditions, Fr. Walter underwent a profound spiritual journey. He surrendered his life to God and gifted us with an extraordinary example of faith, humility, and hope in Christ.

I've noticed several testimonials about the positive, spiritual effects of using the Hallow app this Lent. One that was moving was from a man who shared "Hallow right now is bringing me back to my faith and I will see where it goes. I abandoned my Catholic upbringing because I struggle with religion being the root of so much division and war in our world. I've just recently introduced Hallow and am taking great comfort in welcoming God back into my life."

This Lent, I've been trying to spend less time on social media and more time in quiet and meditative prayer. So it seems like a paradox to me that Hallow's Lent Pray40 challenge is leading me back to my phone. Yet, using this particular app doesn't make me feel like I just wasted a large chunk of time—instead, it's guided me to feeling nourished, inspired, and blessed during my Lenten journey.

This Lent, I've noticed how many people are seeking to go deeper spiritually. So many yearn to return to God and the Church. The Church gives us so many beautiful paths to do so. Astoundingly, this year's Super Bowl commercial, which was broadcast to millions throughout the world, just might have been the voice of the Holy Spirit whispering with a megaphone to each one of us! We have been invited to draw closer to the Lord this Lent and become more fully the person God created us to be. So, here's my commercial: if you have not already done so, I encourage you to download the Hallow app and start following the Lent Pray40 challenge daily. It's never too late to stay prayed up!
