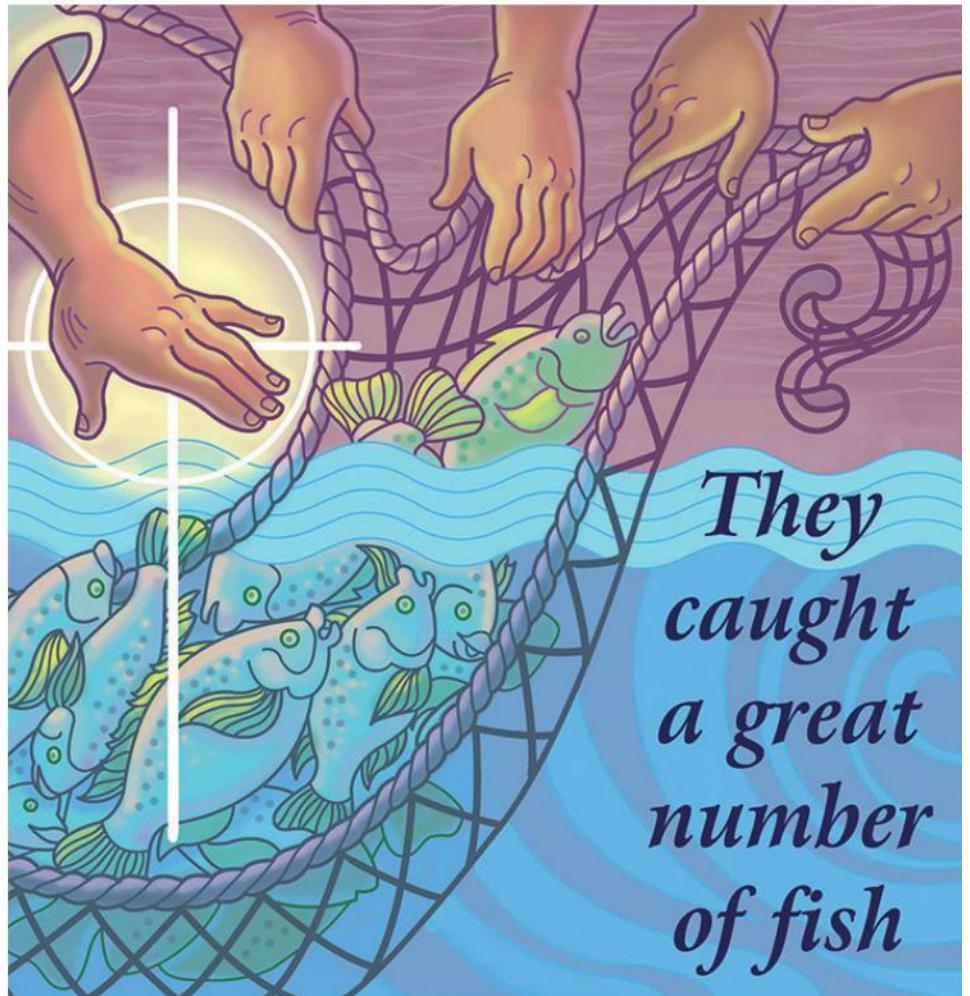

Illinois Pushes for Physician-Assisted Suicide: A Call to Defend Life and Truth

Within the first week of its new session, the Illinois General Assembly introduced legislation seeking to legalize physician assisted suicide, making Illinois the twelfth jurisdiction in the United States to do so. These bills are not just a legal maneuver—they represent a fundamental shift in how our society values human life, particularly the most vulnerable among us.

At its core, this legislation distorts the meaning of compassion, using carefully crafted language to mask its true nature: an attack on the dignity of life. Rather than responding to suffering with love, accompaniment, and true palliative care, this bill seeks to normalize the practice of ending life under the guise of mercy. But our faith teaches us otherwise.

As Catholics, we know suffering has redemptive value when united with Christ. We are called not to eliminate those who suffer but to walk with them, bearing witness to the dignity that God has given each human life. Now is the time to speak boldly against this bill and defend the truth.

We cannot be silent. Will you stand for life?

St. Joseph's Corner

St. Luke records a powerful encounter in Jesus's Ministry. After reading from the scroll of Isaiah, He boldly proclaims, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." Initially, the crowds marveled at his words. These few lines are rich with meaning. Among them is the understanding that the people expected Jesus to perform miracles—perhaps out of a sense of entitlement, thinking they deserved special treatment because Jesus was, like them, a

Nazarene.

But there is more to this encounter. A central theme of particular importance is the universality of God's grace—it is not limited to one town, one nation, or one group of people

When Truth Offends: Why the Crowd Turned on Jesus

Jesus challenges His audience by referencing the widow in Zarephath and Naaman the Syrian, who both received God's blessings when many in Israel were in need. The people responded by driving Jesus out of town.

Why did they react so violently? Jesus confronted them with an uncomfortable truth: God's love and justice are not confined to human expectations or prejudices. Instead of reflecting on His message, they rejected it—and Him—choosing outrage over introspection.

This Gospel challenges us today, especially when we face complex issues that stir strong emotions in the Church, our communities, or even in our own hearts. It's easy to respond defensively, clinging to established views without considering the fullness of truth. Reflecting on St. Thomas Aquinas, I recently wrote: "When sought for its own sake ... truth leads us directly to God." Jesus shows us that truth can often be challenging. It pushes us outside of our comfort zone and calls us to hold conviction and compassion.

Holding Truth and Charity Together

When evaluating critiques of the Church or society, it is vital that we distinguish fact from opinion and guard against broad generalizations. We must be especially wary of opinions we naturally agree with and challenge ourselves to see the argument from alternate perspectives. Just as the people of Nazareth judged Jesus based on their own familiarity— "Isn't this Joseph's son?"—we, too, can fall into the trap of defining entire groups by the actions of a few. The Gospel calls us higher to see the individual, the nuance, and the dignity of every person.

The Church's teaching on immigration reflects this balance. The Catechism acknowledges the right of nations to regulate their borders (CCC 2241) while affirming our Christian duty to welcome strangers with compassion. Justice and mercy are not opposites; they are partners. Seeking justice, when done rightly, is an act of love. And love, without truth, becomes sentimentality, while truth, without love, becomes harshness.

Our Call

Jesus didn't shy away from hard truths, nor did He wield them harshly. He spoke with authority, rooted in love—a love that sought not to condemn but to call hearts to conversion.

We're called to do the same as husbands, fathers, and leaders: to hold firm to what is true, to speak with integrity, and always with a spirit of charity. We should be more willing to challenge our own assumptions than to reject Christ's truth. Rather than focusing on what we think we deserve or feel entitled to, we should remember that all of us—indeed, all of humanity—are equal in our unworthiness before Christ. When faced with difficult conversations, let's remember that our goal isn't to win arguments but to reflect Christ, who is both Truth and Love incarnate.
