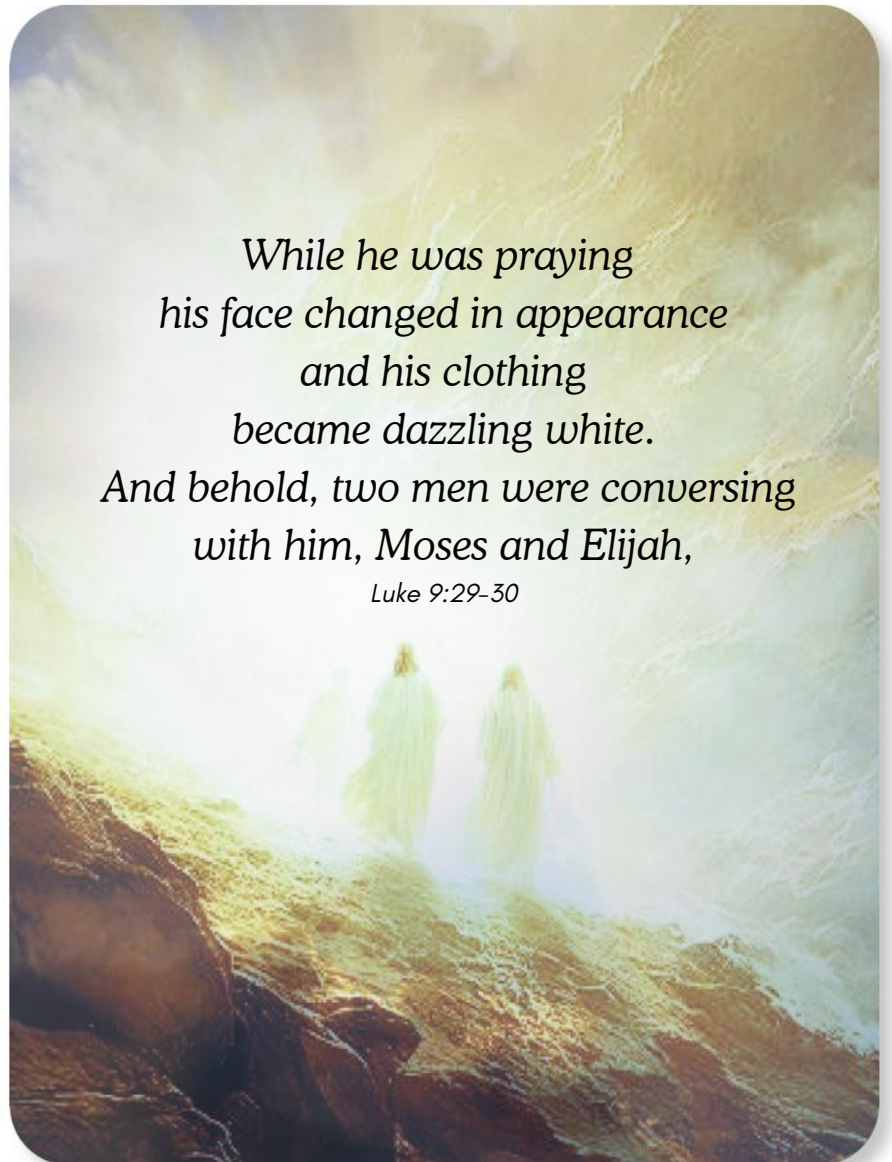

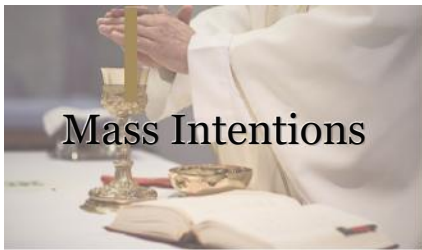

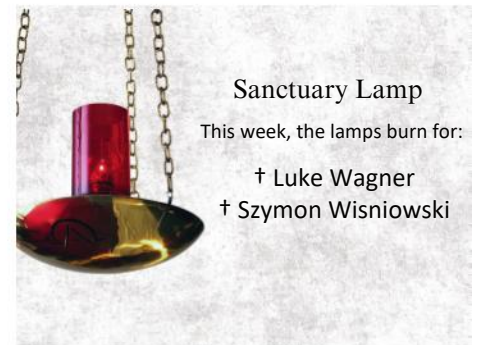

Lenten Family Activity

In addition to "Friday fish day," designate one evening a week for your family to prepare a meal together. Assign a different dish or task to each family member. If your family does not say grace before meals, this is the time to begin.

Before starting, discuss how each family member is giving to each other—giving time, effort, and care to nourish the entire family to go out and be Jesus to others. Begin with a prayer of thanks and petition. Most importantly, keep this family activity beyond Lent. It's a great way for families to connect



St. Joseph's Corner

During Lent, there are certain days so sacred in the Catholic calendar that they rise above ordinary Lenten observance—these are the Solemnities. In the United States, the Feast of St. Patrick might be the first to come to mind, especially as bishops in various dioceses often grant dispensations for the faithful to enjoy corned beef and cabbage. Yet, while St. Patrick's life and missionary zeal remain inspiring, his feast day is not a Solemnity.

Instead, a true Solemnity graces the calendar just two days later—March 19th, the Solemnity of St. Joseph. This week's reflections return to St. Joseph but with a renewed focus on one of his most formidable titles: Terror of Demons. The phrase conjures visions of unyielding strength against the forces of darkness, a striking contrast to the quiet carpenter so often depicted with a staff of lilies.

How did this humble craftsman from Nazareth come to bear a name that strikes fear into the heart of evil? And what does this title mean for us as husbands and fathers today?

Why Is St. Joseph the Terror of Demons?

Unlike other saints who are known for their dramatic battles against evil, St. Joseph's warfare was silent, hidden, and deeply rooted in obedience to God. During his life on earth, he was never known to preach in a public square, cast out demons, or lead armies into battle; yet without wavering, he protected the Holy Family against the forces of hell. In protecting his adopted Son, he safeguarded the very One who would conquer sin and death itself.

Unlike St. Michael the Archangel, who wields a sword against Satan, or St. Benedict, whose exorcism prayers are well-known, St. Joseph left behind no recorded words, no written prayers, and no dramatic exorcisms. And yet, the Church has long recognized that the mere presence of this just and faithful man was enough to strike fear into the forces of hell.

We see faith, the root of all justice, deeply seated in his soul; we see hope, entirely in heaven; and we see charity, which regulated his whole life, and by virtue of which he daily increased in love toward his divine spouse and the Holy Child.
- Pope Leo XIII, *Quamquam Pluries*, 3

This beautiful reflection by Pope Leo XIII articulates why evil quivers at the invocation of St. Joseph's name. His holiness was unparalleled amongst men. Demons, who by their nature flee from all that is holy, could not stand before the purity of the Blessed Virgin Mary or the divinity of the Christ Child, so too did they recoil from the righteousness of St. Joseph—a man who submitted himself fully to God's will, reflecting the heavenly reality of perfect union with God.

A Model for Fathers in Spiritual Warfare

In an age where families are under attack from all sides—spiritually, morally, and culturally—St. Joseph stands as a model of father protection, a reminder of what husbands and fathers are called to be. He shows us that true spiritual warfare is not conducted at the tip of a sword, or while standing upon a soapbox. Evil is not defeated by physical force, hollow words, or gestures of grandeur; evil is defeated by resolute faithfulness, enduring hope, and obedience to God. As men striving to protect our own domestic churches, we can turn to St. Joseph as a guide and intercessor in our daily battles against temptation, fear, and spiritual complacency.

By St. Joseph's example, we husbands and fathers must pick up his weapons—purity, humility, and obedience to God—and protect our families. Just as a carpenter does not build without first refining his tools, neither can we stand as protectors without allowing God to shape and strengthen us.

Refining Ourselves Like St. Joseph

As a craftsman, St. Joseph knew that wood must be shaped, smoothed, and sanded before it could be made into something beautiful and functional. As a man of faith, he allowed himself to be shaped by the hands of God—enduring trials, living in silent trust, and responding to divine commands with unwavering obedience. In doing so, he was not weakened but made stronger. He became a weapon in God's hands, a shield for the Holy Family, and a terror to the forces of darkness.

This Lent, as we prepare to celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, let us pray for the courage to be shaped by God, so that we may become strong and steadfast in our vocation. And when the trials come—when the fire burns and the hammer strikes—may we remember that every blow is not to destroy us, but to refine us, so that we too may be terrors of demons.

St. Joseph, pray for us.
