

We celebrate the Feast of Pentecost this weekend. It is the day that the Apostles received the Holy Spirit, and then went out and preached The Gospel. The word "Pentecost" is Greek in origin and means 50th day. We celebrate Pentecost 50 days after Easter. As Catholics, we celebrate Pentecost as the birth of our Church.

We know that the Apostles were gathered in an upper room on that first Pentecost. A great wind blew in and flames appeared as tongues of fire above the heads of those present. The Holy Spirit came upon those gathered and they began speaking in tongues. Although there was no common language, everyone understood each other. Because the apostles received the Holy Spirit, they then went out and brought The Gospel to others.

As Confirmed Catholic Christians, we all have received the Holy Spirit. We too, can be like the Apostles and bring The Gospel to others. How? We can live as Jesus taught us, or we can become a catechist in our religious education program. We all have the gifts of the Holy Spirit.....we must use them to help each other grow in faith

St. Joseph's Corner

"The Holy Spirit, whose anointing permeates our whole being, is the interior Master of Christian prayer" (CCC 2672).

We celebrate the Feast of Pentecost as a sacrament—a visible sign of a divine truth: Jesus is Lord, and though He is ascended into heaven, He sends

forth His Spirit upon us.

Before a word was preached, or a crowd was baptized, something invisible happened in that upper room: hearts were awakened. The fire that descended did not merely rest above them—it entered into them.

Fifty days ago, they gazed in awe at the empty tomb of the Risen Lord, not knowing how it could be possible, not knowing what they were to do next. They had to see the Lord to believe.

Ten days ago, they watched in awe, staring at the sky as He ascended to heaven. Still, they did not know how it could be possible or what they were to do next. They had to receive the Lord's Spirit to believe.

What Christ had promised now lived within them. What Christ had promised now lives within us. And so began the age of the Spirit, the age of the Church.

The Holy Spirit is the living water "welling up to eternal life" in the heart that prays. It is he who teaches us to accept it at its source: Christ. Indeed in the Christian life there are several wellsprings where Christ awaits us to enable us to drink of the Holy Spirit.

God does not wait for us to reach Him; He stirs our hearts to desire Him. Pentecost, then, is not merely an event to recall, but a reality to receive. In every generation, the Spirit awakens hearts anew. He comes not just to empower—but to dwell within us, to form us from within, and to send us forth in mission.

St. Ignatius of Loyola, master of the interior life, teaches that when God and His angels move within the soul, they bring true joy and spiritual gladness, banishing the sadness and disturbances caused by the enemy (Spiritual Exercises, Rule 1 of the Second Week).

The Spirit's work does not begin with noise and action. It begins with movement—an interior movement that quietly reveals our true identity as beloved sons of the Father, devoted husbands, faithful fathers, and spiritual leaders in our homes. We are not defined by function or status, but by relationship.

Once the Twelve received the Spirit and discovered their identity in Christ, they did not remain in the room. Their hearts, once cloistered by fear, were now opened in love. Their lives, once limited by uncertainty, became free through their witness. God's invitation was no longer something they waited for—it was something they lived. Sent forth in the power of the Spirit, they

became signs of the Kingdom, bearing the presence of Christ into the world.

At Baptism, we receive the same Holy Spirit who descended at Pentecost. He takes up residence within us, embedding our identity as beloved sons of the Father. That identity is not something we invent—it is something we uncover through grace. At Confirmation, we are anointed again with that same Spirit, strengthened for mission, and sent forth to bear witness—not only in word, but in the pattern of our lives.

As with our identity, our mission is not something we invent. It is a response. As sons of the Father, as husbands and fathers, we are called to carry the Spirit we have received into every part of our lives—our families, our work, our Church, our community. The same Spirit who descended upon the Twelve speaks now into our vocation: "Go."

St. Joseph lived this mission. He did not preach to crowds but protected the Living Word. His mission flowed from his identity—he was just a man, a faithful husband, and a protective father. Through this quiet mission, St. Joseph prepared the world for the Redeemer, and he now inspires us to prepare our families for the Kingdom.

Our mission may not be public, but it is no less powerful. We are called to be witnesses in the ordinary: to be men of peace in a world of noise; to build homes where the Spirit dwells; to make decisions not from fear or pride, but from prayer and truth; to lead not through domination, but through sacrificial love.

The Spirit who moved in the Apostles also moved in St. Joseph. And He moves in us. Pentecost is not just what happened—it is what happens when we live as men of the Spirit.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love.


