

The Story of the Church Sign

A sign for our church has been in the planning stages for a very long time, ever since the church was first built. The location for the sign and the pipe under the driveway to run the electric cable were already included in the original site drawings. For many reasons, it never became a reality until now.

This past summer the new committee made it a priority to get a sign installed. Using ideas and input from previous committee members, the decision was made to have a lighted sign with removable letters supported by two stone columns. The Village of Homer Glen does not allow electronic signs. Once the necessary permits were obtained construction began on the sign.

The first step was excavating the holes for the footings and having them approved by the Village for proper depth. Once the approval was granted, the concrete was poured and reinforced with rebar for support. Next the cement block pillars were built, the light box was attached and the electric cable connected. Finally, the stone veneer and top caps completed the pillars. By the end of December, 2016 it was finished. Landscaping around the sign will be done in the spring.

It is our hope that this sign will be a warm and welcoming beacon for everyone in our parish and the surrounding community.
