MISSION STATEMENT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL

The mission of the Parish Council is to bring to life the mission statement of the parish by motivating all parishioners to be involved in one way or the other in all the activities provided by all groups, ministries, committees and commissions.

PURPOSE AND DUTIES

To set Parish goals and objectives for a five year plan and a yearly plan in light of the Diocesan Pastoral Framework and the needs of the Parish.

Encourage by all available means a vigorous and effective lay apostolate involving as many as possible in the pastoral ministries of the Church.

To assist the Pastor in the administration of the Parish through advice, recommendations and cooperation.

Review and approve proposed annual budgets or operating plans of all parish operations and organizations for inclusion in the consolidated parish budget.

To act as an authentic representative voice of the parishioners by providing an open and honest forum of communication and dialogue regarding parish affairs.

Establish effective lines of communication within the parish community.

Prepare and publish for parishioners, annually, a statement of the spiritual, educational, social and financial status, needs and goals of the parish.

QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS

The Parish Council members should have leadership abilities and a willingness to commit time, energy and talents toward building a community of faith, worship and love.

Any lay person shall be eligible for election or appointment to the Parish Council who:

- Has attained the age of 18.
- Is a registered member of the Parish.
- Is willing to represent and foster the ideals and goals of the Parish.
- Has the desire to inspire others.
- Is able to listen and convey parishioners' points of view.

Term is for 3 years.
