

'Down In Adoration Falling' & Corpus Christi

The familiar hymn Tantum Ergo pays homage to our Lord both in the Eucharist and in His glory in the Trinity.

It is part of Pange Lingua, a hymn written by Saint Thomas Aguinas for the Feast of Corpus Christi. This text is in Latin with an English translation below:

Tantum ergo Sacramentum Veneremur cernui: Et antiquum documentum Novo cedat ritui: Sensuum defectui. Genitori, Genitoque Laus et jubilatio, Salus, honor, virtus quoque Sit et benedictio: Procedenti ab utroque Compar sit laudatio. Amen.

Down in adoration falling, Lo! the sacred Host we hail, Lo! o'er ancient forms departing Newer rites of grace prevail; Praestet fides supplementum Faith for all defects supplying, Where the feeble senses fail. To the everlasting Father, And the Son Who reigns on high With the Holy Spirit proceeding Forth from each eternally, Be salvation, honor blessing, Might and endless majesty. Amen.

This hymn plays an important part in the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Tantum Ergo is usually sung before the Benediction when the priest blesses the congregation with the monstrance.

It is also sung during processions of the Blessed Sacrament, where the faithful process behind Him as He is carried in the monstrance.

Spiritual Adoption Program "Mommy felt me kick today"



5 MONTH

Your spiritually adopted baby weighs over one pound now, and his mother can feel his movement. Before this time he was too small for her to feel. Although he swam with ease in his watery world, he needed to be big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside wall and dent it - - the inside wall of the uterus has little feeling. We are mid-way through the pregnancy now. Your prayers have helped your baby's mother continue with her pregnancy and seek the help she needs.

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ What's New?

I never noticed it before, but our reading from Mark's gospel is similar to the story in John's gospel of the wedding feast at Cana. They begin with a problem presented to Jesus: Lack of wine (John) and a place for Passover meal (Mark.) They both involve jars of water. Jesus responds to both by giving orders: to the waiters (Jn) and to the apostles (Mk.) And both have miraculous changes: water into wine (Jn) and bread and wine into Jesus' Body and Blood (Mk.)

Now the wedding feast showed Jesus using the water meant for purification and changing it to wine for a wedding. The Jews needed to purify any dishes in order to keep the kosher laws. But Jesus replaced those laws with a new one, the law of love, symbolized by the wedding. In our gospel today, Jesus replaces ordinary food with spiritual food. He is doing something new, beyond the requirements of the Old Testament.

What does that mean for us? Jesus is showing God's love for us in a new way. You might say he is replacing the way he comes to us. The bread and wine at the last Supper were signs of Jesus' body being broken and his blood poured out for us on the cross. When he gave his life for us, he rose from the dead to give us hope. And now we have the Eucharist, in which he becomes our new food and drink. Just as the Passover meal became a sign of Jesus' real death on the cross, our Eucharist is the sacrament of his real presence among us today.

Do we really believe that the Eucharist is Jesus, the Son of God? The way to measure that is to ask, how has Jesus changed your life? Do you love others more because you know God loves you? Do you have less fear of the future, because the Holy Spirit gives you courage? Do your children know Jesus, because you share your faith with them? In the Eucharist, God gives us a new way to be with him. Let us look forward to being renewed in spirit whenever we receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

The Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus

Every Mass is a commemoration of Jesus' Last Supper and a proclamation and participation of this mystery. Because we may sometimes get lost in the routine of each Sunday's litur-gy, the solemnity of Corpus Christi helps us focus once again on what we are called to do at Mass.

Parishes celebrate the feast day in a variety of ways but regardless of the activity, it's purpose is the same:

- •To remember the night on which Christ celebrated his Last Supper, and during which he shared his own Body and Blood with his friends.
- •To proclaim and participate in the Eucharist as a mystery at the heart of the Catholic faith, as the source and summit of our lives as disciples of Christ.
- •The Feast of Corpus Christi reminds us that at every Mass we are called to:

<u>CELEBRATE</u> what we believe. We express our faith in the risen Christ, who gave his life for us out of love.

LIVE what we believe. We give witness to the risen Christ by our everyday actions in our lives.

BECOME what we receive. We become Christlike, so that others might see in us and in what we do the one who gave his life for us.


