

June: the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus



Jesus appeared to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque explaining the immense love he has for humanity. His heart was visible outside his chest, on fire, and surrounded by

a crown of thorns. These visions continued for 18 months. On June 16, 1675, Jesus asked Sister Margaret Mary to promote a feast that honored his Sacred Heart. Below is a prayer of consecration written by Margaret Mary:

I consecrate and surrender to the Sacred Heart of our Lord Jesus Christ, my person, my life, my difficulties and my sufferings, that I may henceforth live only for his love and glory. It is my firm and unwavering purpose to be his entirely, to do everything for his love and renounce wholeheartedly everything that could displease his divine Heart. O Sacred Heart, I choose You as the sole object of my love, the protector of my life, the pledge of my salvation, the support of my weakness and the atoner for all the sins of my whole life. O mild and bountiful Heart, be likewise my refuge at the hour of death, my justification before God, and ward off from me the penalty of his just wrath. O loving Heart, I place my trust entirely in You. While I fear everything from my own malice, I hope everything from Your goodness. Destroy in me whatever may displease You or be opposed to You, and let Your pure love imprint You so deeply upon my heart that it will be impossible for me ever to forget You or be separated from You. O Sacred Heart, by Your goodness, I implore You, let my name be deeply engraved in You, for in Your service and in Your love I will live and die.

- 10. The best way to learn is to teach—If your own faith education ended years ago, the resources and materials you are exposed to as a catechist will surely refresh and expand your own knowledge.
- 9. Catechists tell the truth—The world needs the message of the Gospel and the way to true happiness; as a catechist, you offer a hungry world that sustenance.
- 8. Sharing the faith is an honor—It's estimated that fewer than 1 percent of Catholics are catechists.
- 7. Your own faith will come alive—As a catechist, you will discover that prayer, liturgy and your own relationship with God will become more vibrant and meaningful.
- 6. You become an active part of the most active part of your parish—When you join the catechists in our parish, you enter into a community that will support you on your faith journey, pray for and with you and encourage you in your Catholic way of life. 5. A catechist is a role model—As a catechist, you get to model behaviors young people might not learn anywhere else.
- 4. You will be practicing stewardship—Being a catechist is a way of being a good steward by giving a bit of your most precious resource -- your time.
- 3. You show your own family that you value religious education—Taking time out of your life to teach the faith shows your own children, grandchildren, siblings and family members that you put a high priority on religious education.
- 2. It's fun—Kids remind adults to live, laugh and pray.
- 1. It's what we are called to do—At the end of his earthly ministry, Jesus said: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations."

- Saying grace before meals, where ever you are. Invite your meal companions to thank God with you.

Bishop Hicks' Column

June 2024





Pope Leo XIII consecrated the entire world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 11, 1899. Since then, every pope has renewed the consecration to the Sacred Heart. As we celebrate this 125th Jubilee of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, I thought I'd share some interesting historical background.

While devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has its roots in medieval Europe, the more contemporary devotion stems from revelations received by the French nun, Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, VHM. In the 1670s, while praying before the Blessed Sacrament, she witnessed the pierced and bleeding heart of Christ with flames and a crown of thorns. After this, she continued to experience multiple apparitions, or images, of Jesus' Sacred Heart, focusing on God's love and mercy.

Fast forward to the turn of the 20th century. In 1917 the world was experiencing political and social upheavals. The stage was being set for World War I which was grimly followed by the horrific World War II. Pope Leo XIII witnessed the rising of secularism, materialism, and other distressing injustices. He had faith that consecrating the world to the Sacred Heart would promote worldly peace and stability through the infinite love of Jesus, which calls us to love one another.

Thirty years ago, during my first month of priesthood, I celebrated Mass on a "First Friday." Afterwards, I remarked to one of the volunteers in the sacristy, "I wonder why there were so many more people at today's Mass." In a matter of fact tone she said, "It is because today is First Friday." I naively asked, "What is First Friday!" She was flabbergasted at my ignorance! Wide-eyed, she blurted, "Father! You do not know what First Friday is? How is that possible?"

Regrettably, I had never been exposed to the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus prior to my ordination to priesthood. But ever since that First Friday Mass and my embarrassing encounter in the sacristy afterwards, I have yearned to grow in my devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

This "First Friday" devotion to attend Mass and receive Holy Communion is rooted in the promises made by

Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary. She wrote the following about Jesus' revelation to her about First Friday: "I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that Its all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on nine first Fridays of consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they will not die under My displeasure or without receiving their sacraments, My divine Heart making Itself their assured refuge at the last moment."

For some Catholics, familiarity with the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is commonplace and may be comfortably integrated within their spiritual lives. For others, there is the possibility of being a baptized, confirmed, and practicing Catholic without ever being exposed to or really knowing anything about this beautiful devotion (like me in the early part of my life).

If you are a "devotee of this devotion," I hold your faithful practices in high regard. Perhaps you'll consider asking someone else - your children, grandchildren, or a friend from church - if they know about the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In a warm and sincere manner, without berating or belittling, you might want to share prayers and information about the Sacred Heart with your family, friends, or faith community. With this evangelizing spirit, we might help others discover and deepen their own relationship with the Sacred Heart, expanding the reach of Christ's love, mercy, and compassion.

As we celebrate the Jubilee of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we also realize that our world faces challenges like it did 125 years ago, with increasing conflicts and complexities. As our world continues to attach itself to secularism, atheism, agnosticism, apathy, injustices, indifferences, and a rejection of morals, values, and faith, we are in need of the power of God's love more than ever. How beautiful and powerful it is that Jesus gave us His very heart, which eternally beats with love, mercy, and compassion for us and the world.

O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, we adore you and we love you. And as we celebrate our fathers -those on this earth and those in heaven, as well as our priests, our spiritual fathers – we ask you to bless them and your Church this Father's Day and always.


