

"Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her" (John 8:7).

These are some of the most powerful words ever spoken. Jesus often spoke out against hypocrisy, and this profound encounter at the Mount of Olives gave the Pharisees yet another opportunity to try to trap Him. Like every time before, Jesus exposed their challenge

in the light of truth—redirecting the focus from condemnation to self-examination.

But this story is not only about exposing Pharisaical hypocrisy—it also reveals something much deeper about the heart of God. In Jesus's response, we see that true righteousness is not rigid or reactionary but rooted in a delicate and divine balance: justice and mercy, held together in perfect harmony. He neither dismisses the seriousness of sin nor denies the dignity of the sinner.

Jesus calls us to transformation, not through shame, but through His grace—inviting each of us to look inward, lay down our stones, and lead with love, not judgment. He calls us to open our hearts to sinners, even those who have sinned against us, just as He opens His heart to us—we who sin against Him.

There is a familiar rhythm in fatherhood: protect, provide, and correct. Yet, too often, we lead with correction first. As men, our instinct is often to fix first and understand later.

In the Gospel, we see Jesus confronted with a situation that demands justice—a pursuit that can often be a true expression of love. But Jesus redirects man's intrinsic tendency to correct through immediate judgment and instead shows us the value of patient contemplation—taking the time to let the transformative power of grace work to correct

injustice by first leading with protection and providing the space for reflection, repentance, and renewal.

Jesus doesn't diminish the severity of sin, nor does He excuse it. The beautiful imagery of Jesus straightening up and finding Himself alone with the woman draws us into a deeply personal moment—one that mirrors the intimacy of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In that sacred encounter, we, too, find ourselves alone with Jesus. Just as the woman stood before Truth and Mercy incarnate, so do we. And when we lay our sins bare before Him, He responds to us as He did to her: "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on, do not sin any more."

As husbands and fathers, we are called to imitate Jesus's love within our own families—not a love that overlooks sin, but a love that sees the person before the mistake, that leads not with condemnation but with compassion. We are called to model the heart of Christ in our homes—to protect, to provide, and only then to correct with wisdom and grace. This is not passive love; it is active, intentional, and deeply courageous.

So, let us lay down the stones of harsh words, impatience, and pride. Let us create space for our wives, our children, and even ourselves to experience grace—space to reflect, to repent, and to be renewed. Let us teach our children what it means to be loved unconditionally, not by mere words, but through our daily actions. Let them see in us men who do not rush to judgment but who pause to pray, who listen before speaking, who correct in love, and who forgive with open arms.

In a world quick to cancel, quick to criticize, quick to condemn—may our homes be places of refuge, restoration, and redemption. This is our calling. This is our privilege. And by God's grace, this is our path

At the end of the National Eucharistic Congress last year, Bishop Cozzens announced there would be a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage from Indianapolis to Los Angeles in 2025.

Upon being asked, Bishop Hicks gratefully accepted the honor for the Diocese of Joliet to be the first Diocese on the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage St. Katharine Drexel Route.

The Diocese of Joliet will receive the Eucharist from the Pilgrims and Chaplains coming from a Mass in Indianapolis, IN on Sunday, May 18 and we will present the Eucharist to the Diocese of Peoria at St. Patrick Parish in Seneca, IL on Monday May 19.


