




STUDENTS

St. Joseph's Corner



The Temptation to Despair

With these words, it would be tempting to conclude that the path to salvation is nearly impossible, that at the end only a few will squeeze through. It might even seem as if God delights in our struggle. But to think this way is to miss the point entirely.

These thoughts are temptations, designed to lead us down a dark road of acedia, shame, and despair. This is the enemy's strategy: first, to convince us that the path to righteousness is unwalkable, too difficult, or reserved for the spiritual elite. Then, once we surrender to acedia—that heavy, listless discouragement that whispers, "why even try?"—he strikes again, taunting us with the shame of not being good enough to walk the journey at all.

The Truth of the Narrow Door

But Christ teaches us the truth. The narrow door is not meant to exclude but to free. Beyond it lies a wide table, where people from east and west, north and south, recline in the Kingdom of God.

The narrow door is not a door of finality but one of daily purification, forcing us to shed the pride, greed, gluttony, and excess that weigh us down. These burdens distort us and make us unfit to pass through. We can only enter as the person the Lord created us to be—light, free, and conformed to His will. When we lay aside our baggage, we find not loss but abundance: a place at His table. There we recline not under the weight of our own striving but receiving from Him the food of eternal life.

Yet Christ will not drag us past the threshold against our will. We must choose to unburden ourselves—surrendering pride, self-will, and worldly attachments. And the time to choose is limited, for the door will not remain open forever. Each day, the invitation is before us: to walk through the narrow door or to remain outside. If we give in to acedia—the noonday devil that dulls our gaze and numbs our desire for God—or if we accept the shame and despair pressed upon us by the enemy, then we risk being left outside when the door finally shuts. And outside, Jesus warns, is "the place of weeping and gnashing of teeth."

The Invitation to Rest

But the Gospel does not end in fear—it ends in invitation. Jesus says, "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). Beyond the narrow door is a wide table. The narrowness is only for a moment; the vastness is eternal. God desires us at His banquet and has paid the ultimate price to make our place secure. The choice is not as impossible as the enemy wants us to believe. Christ assures us, "My yoke is easy, and my burden is light" (Matthew 11:30). Salvation is not the crushing weight of our own efforts, but grace—freely offered, freely received.

Our Call

St. Joseph shows us what this looks like. Walking through the narrow door is not about dramatic public deeds, but about small daily choices of surrender: obedience, humility, and trust. As husbands and fathers, we must imitate him.

Each evening, as we stand at the threshold of our homes, let us make that door narrow. Lay aside the burdens of pride, anger, and despair before you cross. Carry into your home only what is life-giving: faith, hope, and love. In doing so, you will not only pass through the narrow door yourself—you will lead your family through it, toward the banquet of the Lamb.






