



Memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels



UNDY SUNDAY OCTOBER 18/19



Most people take things like underwear for granted. We have found that low-income families and seniors with poverty-level incomes do not spend money on underwear and desperately need it.

During the weekend of October 18 and 19, we will be collecting new personal items such as: underwear, socks, under-shirts, pajamas, and bras to help our neighbors in need.

St. Joseph's Corner

Do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father'; for I tell you, God is able from these stones to raise up children to Abraham.

-Matthew 3:9

We have all crossed the street to avoid the beggar, dismissing his needs as those of a drunkard, not worth the spare change in our pocket. Some of us, knowing the right words, even call this prudence—"I'm helping him by not giving him money." But are we really helping? Even if he is in the grip of addiction, and money may only feed his compulsion, is money truly all we have to give?

The parable of the rich man and Lazarus asks us to do more than decide whether or not to hand over a few coins. It asks us to see Lazarus. It asks us to recognize him as a brother. The rich man did not. He clothed himself in purple and fine linen, feasted sumptuously, and stepped over Lazarus at his gate. He denied Lazarus his dignity, reserving even the scraps from his table for the dogs.

A Chasm Too Late

And when he died, the rich man discovered a truth too late: it is not enough to be a "child of Abraham" in name. It is not enough to claim covenant lineage. He cries out, "Father Abraham, have mercy on me!" But Abraham answers with words that must have cut deeper than the flames: "Between us and you a great chasm has been fixed." Here is the heart of the parable: there is a gulf between name and life, between heritage and holiness, between being baptized into Christ and actually living as His disciple. The rich man is right biologically, but wrong spiritually. He had the covenant in name, but not in life. For Israel, it was not enough to be Abraham's child by blood; one must live Abraham's faith (cf. Galatians 3:7). For us, it is not enough to be baptized and proclaim the Catholic label, wear the crucifix around our neck, and hold the rosary in our hands. Baptism is real adoption, but it is meant to unfold into a life of faith, hope, and charity. To think otherwise is to reduce the sacraments to magic spells, as if they work apart from our faith and conversion. The sacraments always confer grace, but they demand our 'yes' for that grace to bear fruit.

Grafted into Christ

To use St. Paul's images: Baptism is dying and rising with Christ (Romans 6), and like wild branches grafted into the cultivated olive tree (Romans 11), we are joined to His covenant people. But that graft must bear fruit—or else the life of the Vine does not flow through us. As Christ Himself warns, every branch that refuses to bear fruit will be cut off and cast into the fire. Apart from Him, we cannot live. Only in Him—and in continual conversion and repentance—do we bear fruit.

This was the tragedy of the rich man. He claimed Abraham as his father, but his life bore no fruit of Abraham's

faith. His inheritance became a chasm because he never allowed God's gift to take root in deeds of trust, obedience, and mercy.

The truth is bracing: it is not enough to be baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, if we do not live like Abraham, if we do not live like the Son, if we do not walk in the Holy Spirit.

Grace, Not Pelagian Effort

Now, a word of caution. It is easy to mishear this teaching and think: "I must try harder. If I do enough good works, I'll make it to the right side of the chasm."

This is not the Gospel. That is Pelagianism—the ancient heresy that claims we can save ourselves by sheer effort of the will, as if grace were optional. But grace is not optional. We cannot earn salvation. We do not climb our way into Christ's life by works; rather, we receive His life as a gift, and from that gift, good works flow.

The Christian life is not about straining harder—it is about surrendering deeper. Yet surrender does not make us passive; it makes our efforts fruitful, because they are empowered by grace. We abandon ourselves, our will, and our disordered desires, and we embrace Christ: the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

This is why St. Joseph matters so much. He did not rely on heritage, nor did he attempt to save himself by sheer effort. He received God's word, trusted it, and obeyed in silence. His greatness was not in self-will but in surrender. St. Joseph shows us that the life of Abraham, the life of Christ, is lived not by striving harder but by yielding more completely to grace.

Our Call

As husbands and fathers, this parable confronts us with urgency. It is not enough to rely on our heritage or on sacramental checklists. It is not enough to wear the title "Catholic dad" while stepping over the Lazarus at our gate—whether that Lazarus is our wife's unspoken needs, our children's hunger for our attention, or the neighbor who silently suffers.

Our call is to live Abraham's faith, to live Christ's obedience, and to let the Holy Spirit shape every choice of our lives. That does not mean saving ourselves by sheer willpower; it means receiving grace as St. Joseph did—attentively, humbly, decisively. The rich man's tragedy was presumption. St. Joseph's greatness was surrender.

Brothers, the gulf that is fixed after death is determined by the choices we make today. Every act of love builds a bridge; every act of neglect deepens the chasm. The question is not whether we can call Abraham "father." The question is whether we will live as true sons in the Son.


