

# How To Observe Lent

Lent is a 40-day period of reflection, repentance, and renewal leading up to Easter.

## Lent begins on Ash Wednesday

- Although Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day Of Obligation, it is one of the most significant days in the liturgical calendar.
- It is one of the two days in the year when the Church mandates Fasting and Abstinence

## Need some ideas for Lent this year?

### Prayer

- Spend time each day in prayer and try different kinds of prayer: traditional liturgical prayers, spontaneous prayers that come from the heart, and lectio divina (meditative reading and reflection on a passage of scripture).
- Make a point to visit our **Adoration Chapel** every week during Lent. Jesus waits for you in our Adoration Tabernacle. Spend time with him! **Call the Parish Office for instructions on how to gain access to the chapel.**

### Fasting

- It is common for people to fast during Lent by giving up a particular food or activity for the 40-day period.
- Choose a fast that is meaningful and challenging for you, but also realistic and sustainable. You can fast from activities or habits that distract you from your time with God, such as social media, or gossip.

### Almsgiving

- This is the practice of giving to those in need, whether through donations or acts of service.
- **Try out a new volunteer role at our parish. We need collection counters, Ministers of Communion, Lectors, Sacristans, and Ushers.** You get to choose when you volunteer.
- Be open to the ways in which God may be calling you to serve others and to be a presence of love and compassion in the world.

# Fasting and Abstinence Guide

## WHAT IS FASTING?

One meal for the day with two small 'meals'. The smaller meals added together cannot exceed the one full meal.



### WHO IS REQUIRED TO FAST?

Catholics 18 - 59 years of age

### WHEN TO FAST?

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday

## WHAT IS ABSTINENCE?

It is refraining from eating the meat of mammals and fowl. However, fish and other marine animals are allowed



### WHO IS REQUIRED TO ABSTAIN?

Catholics 15 and older

### WHEN TO ABSTAIN?

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during lent

## What We Can Do For Lent

Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday. As Catholic Christians, we prepare ourselves during Lent by fasting, praying and giving alms....ie giving of ourselves to others.

**Jesus came to serve, not to be served.**

There are many things from which we can fast, not solely giving up food, candy or our favorite beverages. We can fast from doing good and not so good things.

### Some examples of good things from which we can fast:

- Facebook/social media
- Hitting the snooze button-get up and pray
- Staying up late-give yourself a bedtime and pray before bed. Download the Hallow app for many prayer options. It's free for a limited time.
- Checking your phone when you are present with people-eating, visiting, or in someone's presence.

### Some examples of not so good things from which we can fast:

- Complaining
- Being lazy-try exercising or taking a walk
- Lying, swearing, taking our Lord's name in vain
- Judging others

Let's journey through Lent together, making ourselves a better version of "us" by fasting.





**Bishop Dennis E. Spies  
Appointed Apostolic  
Administrator for the  
Diocese of Joliet**

[February 6, 2026] — The Diocese of Joliet announces that Bishop Dennis E. Spies has been appointed Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Joliet, effective immediately. Bishop Spies assumes this role in accordance with the norms of the Catholic Church, ensuring continuity of leadership and pastoral care for the nearly half-million Catholics across the seven counties of the diocese.

Bishop Spies, who has been serving as Auxiliary Bishop of Joliet and Titular Bishop of Cenculiana, brings more than two decades of pastoral, administrative, and formational experience to this responsibility. Ordained to the priesthood in 2002, he has served the Diocese of Joliet as pastor, seminary formator, and most recently as Vicar for Clergy, a role in which he has been widely recognized for his pastoral sensitivity, collaborative leadership style, and deep commitment to the well-being of priests and parish communities.

“I am humbled by the trust placed in me and remain committed to serving the people of God in the Diocese of Joliet with faith, integrity, and hope,” Bishop Spies said. “Together, we will continue to proclaim the Gospel, strengthen our parishes, and accompany one another as disciples of Jesus Christ.”

As Administrator, Bishop Spies will oversee the day-to-day governance of the diocese until the appointment of a new diocesan bishop. His responsibilities include supporting diocesan ministries, guiding clergy, and ensuring the smooth functioning of pastoral and administrative operations. Born in Clifton, Illinois, Bishop Spies earned his undergraduate degree from Southern Illinois University Carbondale before completing seminary studies at Mundelein Seminary. He was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Joliet by Pope Francis in 2024 and ordained later that year at the Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus.

## St. Joseph's Corner

This week's Gospel is often referred to as the Six Antitheses, and fittingly falls just before we begin the six-week period of repentance we call Lent. But the connections run far deeper than a numerical parallel.

The lectionary opens with a reading from the Book of Sirach, where the prophet teaches that choosing to keep the commandments leads to life: "If you choose, you can keep the commandments; they will save you" (Sir 15:15). I touched on this same theme recently in reflecting on the Beatitudes—that the Decalogue is necessary precisely because it protects against death.

Jesus makes His mission unmistakably clear. He has not come to abolish the Law—presumably leaving us exposed to death—but to fulfill it. In the original Greek, the word translated as fulfill is πληρώω (plērōō). This term carries a depth of meaning that goes well beyond our ordinary notions of complying with, obeying, or merely satisfying the requirements of the Law.

Πληρώω means to fill to the full—to bring something to completion, to actualize it according to its intended end. Christ does not present Himself as a stricter lawgiver, but as the One in whom the Law finally becomes what it was always meant to be.

As Jesus lays out each of the Six Antitheses, He does not describe the bare minimum required to avoid death, but the deep interior disposition necessary for true human flourishing. He reveals what it means to live according to the purpose of our creation—where life is not merely preserved, but perfected, and where we are drawn into communion with God through Christ.

Jesus challenges us not simply to live, but to live in Him—where what once amounted to mere survival is transformed into thriving, and where refraining from harm gives way to the costly call of willing ourselves for our neighbor's good.

*"The law was given that grace might be sought; grace was given that the law might be fulfilled."*

The Church gives us a clear prescription for a fruitful Lent: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These disciplines are good in themselves, but they also open a deeper invitation—to examine our telos, the purpose for which we were created.

We are called not merely to pray, but to live the interior disposition of prayer: a contemplative openness to the communion for which we were made. We are invited not simply to fast, but to hunger for the fullness that Christ alone can satisfy. And we are asked not only to give to the poor, but to empty ourselves more completely, that we might be filled by God.

In the end, the righteousness Christ calls for is not a heavier burden, but a fuller life. What the Law once preserved from death, grace now draws toward glory. Dear brothers, as we stand at the threshold of Lent, let the question be not whether we keep the commandments, but whether we will allow them—fulfilled in Christ—to finish their work in us. This is the quiet labor of the season: not the perfection of appearances, but the patient conversion of the heart, until what begins in discipline is brought to completion in love.

## SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



**Baptism:** Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



**Marriage:** The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



**Funerals:** The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home to make the arrangements. The funeral home will then contact the Faith Formation Office at Our Mother of Good Counsel (OMGC) to notify us about the upcoming funeral Mass. We (OMGC) will get in touch with the family and work together to organize the funeral liturgy.
