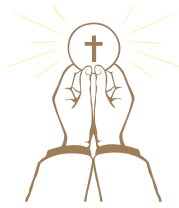

A WORD FROM FR. GREG

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday is the feast of Our Lady of Good Counsel. Did you know "Our Lady" and "Our Mother" are used interchangeably in her title? Our Augustinian founders prefer to use the literal Latin translation of the devotion "Mater Boni Consilii", which is "Our Mother of Good Counsel."

As we look toward May, a month dedicated to the Blessed Mother, I want to share the miraculous history of our namesake with you.

In a small town, Genazzano, Italy, a woman named Petruccia felt a calling to restore her village's crumbling church. She used her life savings in the rebuilding effort but depleted her funds before the roof was completed. Many townspeople openly mocked her, but Petruccia continued to pray, trusting that heaven would provide a way to finish the sanctuary.

On April 25, 1467, during a town festival, the crowds suddenly heard beautiful, heavenly music. They looked up and saw a luminous cloud descend from the sky, coming to rest directly on the unfinished wall of Petruccia's church. When the cloud dissipated, a beautiful, eggshell-thin fresco of the Blessed Mother and the Christ Child remained. Astonishingly, the image appeared to be suspended without any visible support behind it.

Shortly after, two refugees from Albania arrived in Genazzano. They were stunned at the sight of this image. They claimed the fresco originated in their hometown church but vanished during an invasion. They had followed this glowing image, as it miraculously traveled across the Adriatic Sea, guiding them to safety.

Within the first months of this image's appearance, over 170 miraculous healings were recorded. Centuries later, an aerial bomb crashed through the church during World War 2. The church was destroyed except for this incredibly fragile plaster fresco.

Popes throughout history have looked to our patroness for guidance. Pope John XXIII made a pilgrimage to her shrine before the Second Vatican Council, asking for guidance. Pope Leo XIII was so moved by her intercession that he officially added the title "Mother of Good Counsel" to the Litany of Loreto in 1903.

A Special Invitation for May:

I am happy to share with you that, inspired by the guidance of our patroness, we will begin a special **devotion to the Litany of Loreto on Thursdays in May following the 8:00 am Mass.**

Let us ask for the Blessed Mother's intercession and wise counsel in our own lives. May Our Mother of Good Counsel always guide and protect you!

Droga Rodzino Parafialna,

W tę niedzielę obchodzimy święto Matki Bożej Dobrej Rady. Warto zauważyć, że określenia „Matka Boża” i „Nasza Matka” są używane zamiennie w Jej tytule. Nasi augustiańscy założyciele chętnie posługują się dosłownym tłumaczeniem łacińskiego wezwania Mater Boni Consilii, które oznacza „Nasza Matka Dobrej Rady”.

Wraz ze zbliżającym się majem – miesiącem szczególnie poświęconym Najświętszej Maryi Pannie – pragnę podzielić się z Wami niezwykłą historią naszej Patronki.

W niewielkim miasteczku Genazzano we Włoszech żyła kobieta imieniem Petruccia, która poczuła wezwanie, aby odbudować podupadający kościół w swojej miejscowości. Przeznaczyła na ten cel wszystkie swoje oszczędności, jednak zabrakło jej środków, zanim ukończono dach. Wielu mieszkańców otwarcie z niej szydziło, lecz Petruccia nie przestawała się modlić, ufając, że Bóg znajdzie sposób, by dokończyć budowę świątyni.

25 kwietnia 1467 roku, podczas miejskiego święta, zgromadzeni nagle usłyszeli piękną, niebiańską muzykę. Spojrzeli w górę i ujrzeli świetlistą chmurę zstępującą z nieba, która zatrzymała się przy niedokończonej ścianie kościoła. Gdy chmura się rozproszyła, ukazał się niezwykle delikatny fresk przedstawiający Matkę Bożą z Dzieciątkiem Jezus. Co zadziwiające, obraz zdawał się unosić w powietrzu, bez widocznego podparcia.

Niedługo potem do Genazzano przybyło dwoje uchodźców z Albanii. Zdumieni widokiem obrazu, rozpoznali w nim fresk ze swojego rodzinnego kościoła, który zniknął podczas najazdu. Jak opowiadali, podążali za nim, gdy w cudowny sposób przemieszczał się przez Morze Adriatyckie, prowadząc ich ku bezpiecznemu miejscu.

W ciągu pierwszych miesięcy od pojawienia się obrazu odnotowano ponad 170 cudownych uzdrowień. Wieki później, podczas II wojny światowej, bomba lotnicza przebiła dach kościoła. Świątynia została niemal całkowicie zniszczona – ocalał jedynie ten niezwykle kruchy fresk.

Papieże na przestrzeni wieków powierzali się opiece naszej Patronki. Papież Jan XXIII odbył pielgrzymkę do Jej sanktuarium przed rozpoczęciem Soboru Watykańskiego II, prosząc o światło i prowadzenie. Papież Leon XIII, poruszony Jej wstawiennictwem, w 1903 roku oficjalnie włączył wezwanie „Matko Dobrej Rady” do Litanii Loretańskiej.

Happy Easter! As we continue celebrating the joy of the Resurrection, I have a special request for the people of our diocese on behalf of our brothers and sisters in Kankakee County.

World Day of Prayer for Vocations April 26, 2026

The World Day of Prayer for Vocations fulfills the Lord's instruction to, "*Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest*". As the climax of this prayer, continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life. While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), consecrated life in all its forms (male and female religious life, societies of apostolic life, consecrated virginity, secular institutes), and to the missionary life.

2026 marks the 63rd Anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations



Beginning this weekend, we will be participating in the Annual Baby Bottle Project with the Women's Centers of Greater Chicagoland that has continued to provide counseling and support for women considering abortion. Baskets of bottles will be available in the Narthex.

The Baby Bottle Project enables the whole family to participate in helping The Women's Centers of Greater Chicagoland's pro-life mission. Empty baby bottles are dispersed at local parishes and schools for families and students to bring home and collect their spare change to help fund the work that we do. At the same time, participants pray for women and children who are vulnerable to abortion. This project is a wonderful way for the community to show its support for life and for children to learn the beauty of giving to help others.

This year you have a choice of how you would like to help. You can take a Baby Bottle home to fill with change and return it to church on May 9th/10th. If you would prefer not to take a physical bottle, you can make a Virtual Baby Bottle donation at the website for the Women's Centers.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



Marriage: The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



Funerals: The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home. The funeral home will then contact us at Our Mother of Good Counsel about the upcoming funeral Mass. We will then get in touch with the family to organize the funeral liturgy.



Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized: If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits: Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



Religious Education: We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
