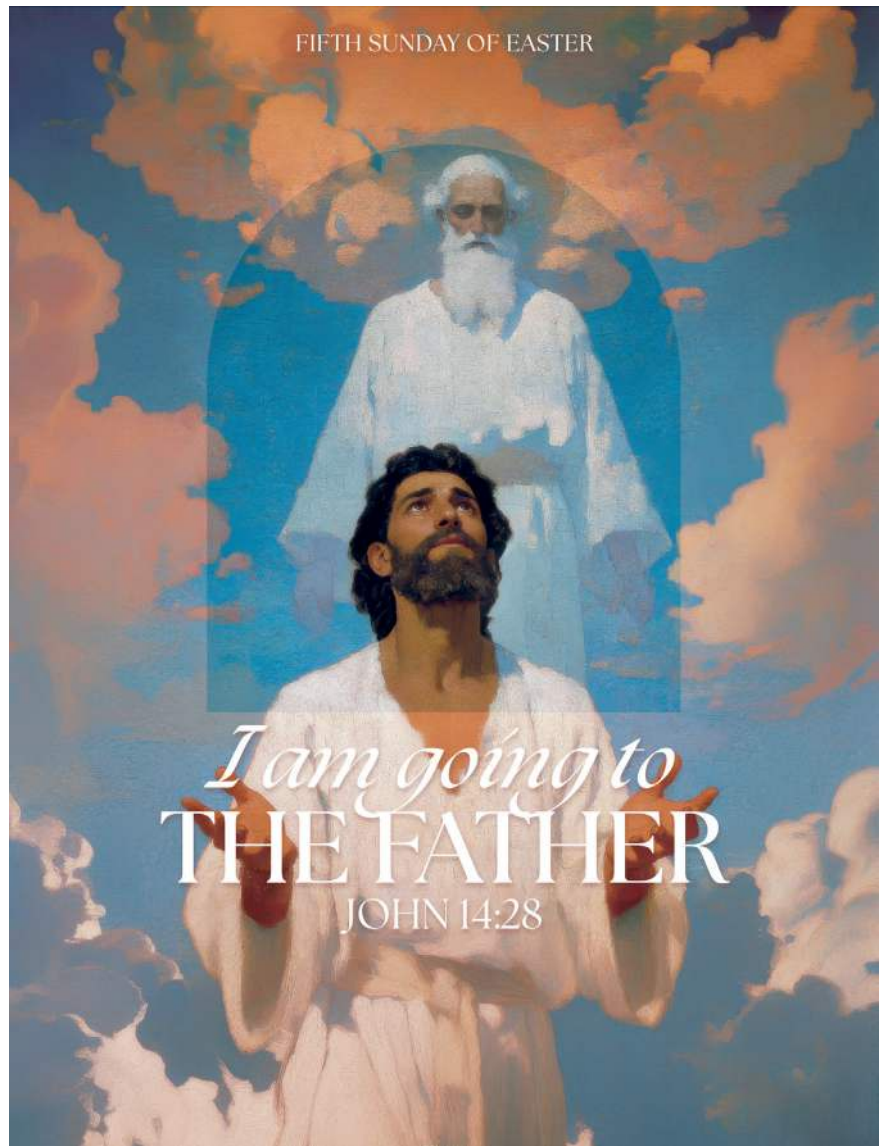

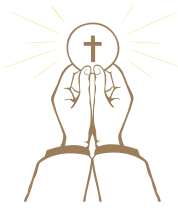

A WORD FROM FR. GREG

The Gift of the Eucharist:
Bringing Christ to Our Community

Dear Parish Family,

This is a joyful season for our parish as we celebrate one of the most beautiful and sacred sacraments with our children's First Holy Communion. The Eucharist is the very heart of our Catholic life, and witnessing these young souls receive Jesus for the first time is a reminder of the incredible gift we are offered at every Mass.

This year, we are especially blessed to host four groups receiving their First Communion here in our sanctuary. This is a wonderful reflection of how we are bringing Jesus to the community as a whole. Last week, we celebrated with our Religious Education (RE) students. This weekend, we welcome the students from Everest Academy to the Lord's table. In the coming weeks, we will continue the joy as we celebrate with the children from Adam Mickiewicz Polish School and King Casimir Polish School. Seeing so many young people from different groups united in this sacrament is a visible example of the reach of Christ's love.

At the center of all these celebrations is the absolute sacredness of Jesus' Body, truly present in the Eucharist. I will touch more on this subject as we approach the Feast of Corpus Christi in June. Participating in the Mass and receiving the Eucharist is the most important thing we do as Catholics. Jesus gave Himself entirely to us on the cross, and He desires to continue coming to us, dwelling within us, and nourishing us through this holy sacrament today.

Because the Eucharist is such an important gift, we are always looking for individuals to help share it. I want to invite you to join the mission of bringing Christ to our fellow Catholics by volunteering as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.

The Church grants permission for laypeople to assist in distributing Holy Communion, which is a special way to serve the parish. Communion Ministers often share how moving the experience is. There is a profound grace in looking your fellow brothers and sisters in the eye and presenting them with the physical gift of Jesus. It is an incredible privilege.

If you feel called to participate in the Mass in this way, I strongly encourage you to try it out. We will provide all the necessary guidance and support. Please consider whether the Lord is calling you to help share the sacred gift of His Body with your community.

Dar Eucharystii:
Przynosząc Chrystusa naszej wspólnotcie

Droga Rodzino Parafialna,

To radosny czas dla naszej parafii, ponieważ świętujemy z naszymi dziećmi jeden z najpiękniejszych i najświętszych sakramentów – Pierwszą Komunię Świętą. Eucharystia jest prawdziwym sercem naszego katolickiego życia, a widok tych młodych dusz, które po raz pierwszy przyjmują Jezusa, przypomina nam o niezwykłym darze, jaki otrzymujemy podczas każdej Mszy Świętej.

W tym roku jesteśmy szczególnie pobłogosławieni, ponieważ w naszym kościele gościmy cztery grupy dzieci przystępujących do Pierwszej Komunii Świętej. Jest to piękne świadectwo tego, jak przynosimy Jezusa całej naszej wspólnotcie. W ubiegłym tygodniu świętowaliśmy z uczniami naszego programu katechetycznego (RE). W ten weekend witamy uczniów z Everest Academy przy stole Pańskim. W nadchodzących tygodniach będziemy kontynuować tę radość, celebrując Pierwszą Komunię dzieci z Polskiej Szkoły im. Adama Mickiewicza oraz Polskiej Szkoły im. Króla Kazimierza Wielkiego. Widok tak wielu młodych ludzi z różnych grup zjednoczonych w tym sakramencie jest widzialnym znakiem zasięgu miłości Chrystusa.

W centrum wszystkich tych uroczystości znajduje się absolutna świętość Ciała Jezusa, prawdziwie obecnego w Eucharystii. Do tego tematu powrócę jeszcze szerzej, gdy będziemy zbliżać się do uroczystości Bożego Ciała w czerwcu. Uczestnictwo we Mszy Świętej i przyjmowanie Eucharystii jest najważniejszą rzeczą, jaką czynimy jako katolicy. Jezus oddał się nam całkowicie na krzyżu i pragnie nadal przychodzić do nas, zamieszkiwać w nas oraz umacniać nas przez ten święty sakrament także dzisiaj.

Ponieważ Eucharystia jest tak wielkim darem, zawsze poszukujemy osób, które pomogą ją rozdawać. Chciałbym zaprosić Was do włączenia się w misję przynoszenia Chrystusa naszym braciom i siostram w wierze poprzez posługę Nadzwyczajnego Szafarza Komunii Świętej.

Kościół udziela świeckim pozwolenia na pomoc w udzielaniu Komunii Świętej, co jest wyjątkowym sposobem służby parafii. Szafarze Komunii często mówią o tym, jak poruszające jest to doświadczenie. Jest szczególna łaska w spotkaniu z braćmi i siostrami we wierze oraz w podawaniu im samego Jezusa obecnego w Eucharystii. To naprawdę niezwykle przywilej.

Jeśli czujesz, że Pan powołuje Cię do uczestniczenia we Mszy Świętej w ten sposób, gorąco zachęcam, abyś spróbował. Zapewnimy wszelkie potrzebne wskazówki i wsparcie. Proszę, zastanów się, czy Pan nie wzywa Cię do pomocy w dzieleniu się świętym darem Jego Ciała ze swoją wspólnotą.

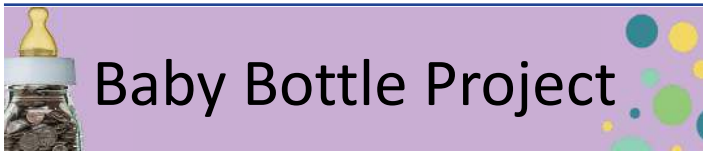

"I had a dream!"

Your baby's brain has begun maturing – a process that will continue until she is about 14 years old. Her eyelids are now sealed and will re-open at 7 months. Her taste buds are now working. Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her within an hour or two. Three hundred quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to parents of the baby can be seen at this time. This month REMS (rapid eye movements) have been recorded – a sign of dreaming. Your baby is now about 9 inches in length. Thank you for praying!

FIFTH SUNDAY - GREATER THINGS THAN JESUS?

Of all the promises Jesus gave to his disciples, sometimes I find the one at the end of today's Gospel to be the most amazing of all. Jesus tells his disciples that they would do greater works than he did. What could be greater than walking on water, curing a blind man, raising the dead, or feeding five thousand people with only a few loaves of bread?

First, we have to ask what Jesus would think is greater. The apostles performed many miracles because of their faith in the Lord. They cured the sick, and Peter even brought a dead woman back to life (Acts 9:40). But even these signs are not greater than what Jesus did.

I think Jesus meant greater in the sense of the true work of a disciple. The disciples started right after Pentecost, when they received the power of the Holy Spirit. Peter went outside and began preaching to the people, resulting in three thousand people being baptized.

I wonder if we have that same kind of trust in Jesus that the apostles had. Maybe we have to start like they did. They talked about their experience of finding the empty tomb. They prayed, they discussed what had happened, and they looked for Jesus to appear to them. We can do those same things. We can talk about our faith with our families or in a parish discussion group. We can pray to be filled with the gifts of the Spirit and to see Jesus in other people. And we can look for God to act in our lives so that we can share God's love, which has been given to us, with those who do not know the Lord.

Większe rzeczy niż Jezus?

Spośród wszystkich obietnic, które Jezus dał swoim uczniom, czasami najbardziej zadziwia mnie ta z końca dzisiejszej Ewangelii. Jezus mówi swoim uczniom, że będą dokonywać większych dzieł niż On sam. Cóż może być większego niż chodzenie po wodzie, uzdrowienie niewidomego, wskrzeszenie umarłych czy nakarmienie pięciu tysięcy ludzi kilkoma chlebami?

Najpierw musimy zapytać, co Jezus uważałby za „większe”. Apostołowie dokonywali wielu cudów dzięki swojej wierze w Pana. Uzdrowiali chorych, a św. Piotr nawet przywrócił do życia zmarłą kobietę (Dz 9,40). Jednak nawet te znaki nie są większe od tego, czego dokonał Jezus.

Myślę, że Jezus miał na myśli „większe” w znaczeniu prawdziwego dzieła ucznia. Uczniowie rozpoczęli je zaraz po Pięćdziesiątnicy, kiedy otrzymali moc Ducha Świętego. Piotr wyszedł wtedy do ludzi i zaczął głosić Ewangelię, czego owocem było ochrzcenie trzech tysięcy osób.

Zastanawiam się, czy my mamy takie samo zaufanie do Jezusa, jakie mieli apostołowie. Może musimy zacząć tak jak oni. Rozmawiali o swoim doświadczeniu odnalezienia pustego grobu. Modlili się, rozważali to, co się wydarzyło, i oczekiwali, że Jezus im się ukaże. My również możemy czynić to samo. Możemy rozmawiać o naszej wierze z rodziną lub w parafialnej grupie dyskusyjnej. Możemy modlić się o napełnienie darami Ducha Świętego i o to, by dostrzegać Jezusa w innych ludziach. Możemy też wypatrywać działania Boga w naszym życiu, aby dzielić się Jego miłością, którą sami otrzymaliśmy, z tymi, którzy jeszcze nie znają Pana.

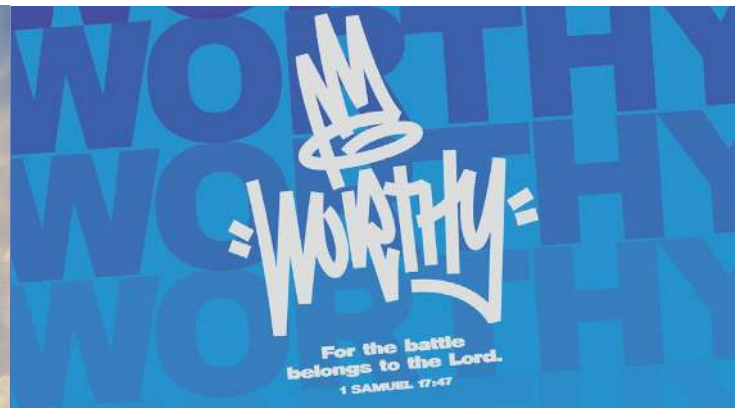

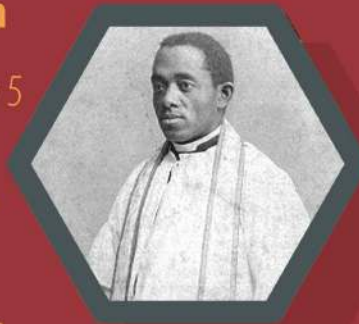

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



Marriage: The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



Funerals: The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home. The funeral home will then contact us at Our Mother of Good Counsel about the upcoming funeral Mass. We will then get in touch with the family to organize the funeral liturgy.



Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized: If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits: Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



Religious Education: We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
