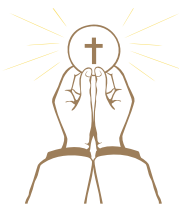

## A WORD FROM FR. GREG

Dear Parishioners,

In Catholic tradition, the entire month of May is dedicated to honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary, so it is fitting that we also celebrate Mother's Day in May. As we take time to honor and pray

for the earthly mothers, grandmothers, and mother figures who have nurtured us, it is also a beautiful time to reflect on Mary's role as our spiritual mother and to ask for her intercession.

The theme of Mary gives us a wonderful opportunity to talk about a rich part of our Catholic heritage: devotions.

**Devotions** are practices of piety that deepen our relationship with God. While the Mass and the Sacraments are the center of our faith, devotions are the prayers, customs, and practices that extend grace into our daily lives. Praying the Rosary, walking the Stations of the Cross, or wearing a miraculous medal are all examples of devotions that help focus our hearts and minds on Christ.

In this spirit, we will be praying a special Marian devotion this month. Following the Thursday 8:00 AM Mass and the Sunday 12:00 PM Mass, we will be praying the Litany of Loreto.

If you have never prayed a litany before, it is a beautiful, rhythmic form of prayer consisting of a series of petitions followed by a fixed response, such as "Pray for us." The Litany of Loreto, also known as the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is one of the most beloved. We are invoking Mary under a series of beautiful, poetic titles such as Mystical Rose, Tower of David, Cause of Our Joy, and Queen of Peace.

The origins of this specific litany date back to the Middle Ages. It gets its name from the Holy House of Loreto, a famous Marian shrine in Italy. In the shrine, there are three walls of stacked stones. It is believed that these are transported walls from Mary's home, where the Annunciation occurred, and where the Holy family resided. Pilgrims visiting Loreto would chant this litany with such great devotion that it eventually spread and was officially approved by Pope Sixtus V in 1587.

I invite you to pray this beautiful litany with us. If you are unable to attend, I encourage you to pray the Litany yourself during the month of May.

Let us ask our Blessed Mother to wrap her mantle of protection around our parish, our families, and our hearts.

Drodzy Parafianie,

W tradycji katolickiej cały miesiąc maj poświęcony jest czci Najświętszej Maryi Panny, dlatego również w maju obchodzimy Dzień Matki. Gdy zatrzymujemy się, aby uczcić i otoczyć modlitwą nasze ziemskie mamy, babcie oraz wszystkie osoby pełniące rolę matek, jest to także piękny czas, aby rozważyć rolę Maryi jako naszej duchowej Matki i prosić Ją o wstawiennictwo.

Temat Maryi daje nam wspaniałą okazję, aby przypomnieć sobie ważną część naszego katolickiego dziedzictwa: nabożeństwa.

Nabożeństwa to praktyki pobożności, które pogłębiają naszą relację z Bogiem. Chociaż Msza Święta i sakramenty są centrum naszej wiary, nabożeństwa to modlitwy, zwyczaje i praktyki, które przenoszą łaskę w nasze codzienne życie. Modlitwa różańcowa, Droga Krzyżowa czy noszenie medalika cudownego są przykładami nabożeństw, które pomagają nam skupić serce i umysł na Chrystusie.

W tym duchu w tym miesiącu będziemy modlić się szczególnym nabożeństwem maryjnym. Po Mszy Świętej o 8:00 rano w czwartki oraz po Mszy Świętej o 12:00 w niedziele będziemy odmawiać Litanię Loretańską.

Jeśli nigdy wcześniej nie odmawiałeś litanii, jest to piękna, rytmiczna forma modlitwy składająca się z serii wezwań zakończonych stałą odpowiedzią, taką jak „Módl się za nami”. Liturgia Loretańska, znana również jako Litania do Najświętszej Maryi Panny, jest jedną z najbardziej ukochanych modlitw. Wzywamy w niej Maryję pod wieloma pięknymi, poetyckimi tytułami, takimi jak: Mistyczna Róża, Wieża Dawidowa, Przyczyno naszej radości czy Królowo Pokoju.

Początki tej litanii sięgają średniowiecza. Jej nazwa pochodzi od Świętego Domu w Loreto, słynnego sanktuarium maryjnego we Włoszech. W sanktuarium znajdują się trzy ściany z kamiennych bloków. Uważa się, że są to przeniesione ściany z domu Maryi, miejsca Zwiastowania i życia Świętej Rodziny. Pielgrzymi odwiedzający Loreto odmawiali tę litanię z tak wielką pobożnością, że z czasem rozpowszechniła się ona i została oficjalnie zatwierdzona przez papieża Sykstusa V w 1587 roku.

Serdecznie zapraszam do wspólnej modlitwy tą piękną litanią. Jeśli nie możesz być obecny, zachęcam do odmawiania Litanii Loretańskiej w domu w ciągu miesiąca maja.

Prośmy naszą Najświętszą Matkę, aby otoczyła płaszczem swojej opieki naszą parafię, nasze rodziny i nasze serca.

**Our Lady asks us to:**

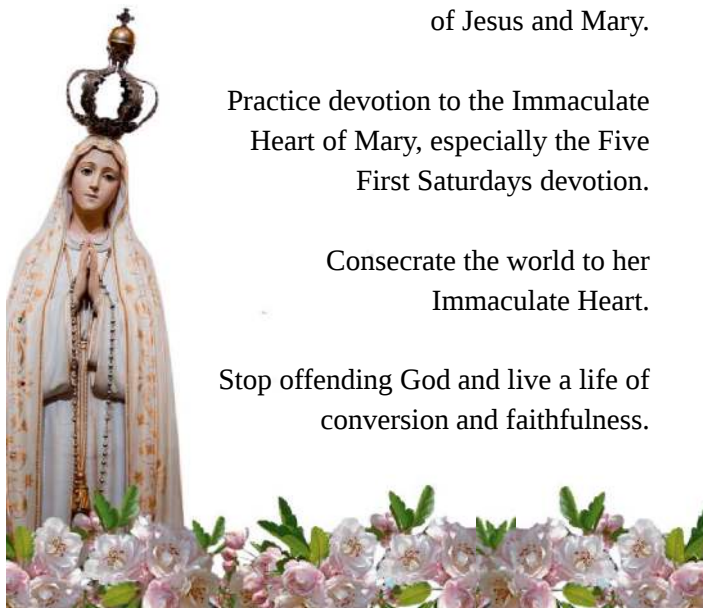
Pray the Rosary daily for peace in the world and an end to war.

## SIXTH SUNDAY - SHARE IN THE POWER

This Sunday is two weeks before Pentecost, but already the readings prepare us for that feast. The first reading from Acts shows us the conversion of the Samaritans, thanks to Philip's preaching and curing the sick. He did this through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit makes Jesus present today, not just in the sacraments, but through us, his disciples.

Jesus knew that after his Resurrection appearances, he would not be visible as a man. Instead, he would live in all of his followers through the power of the Holy Spirit. That's why he tells the disciples that the Spirit will be with them and in them. So the Sacrament of Confirmation, the laying on of hands (Acts 8:17), reminds us that when God lives in us, we share in the power of the Holy Spirit.

In the second reading, Peter gives us advice. First, he tells us about our hope in the Lord. That hope comes from our faith in the Resurrection. People saw and talked to Jesus after he rose, and anyone who follows Jesus will share in that resurrection. Next, Peter tells us to avoid sin to show that we can live a life free from sin, selfishness, and hatred. Freedom from sin allows us to give a good example of how to live. Abandoning selfishness allows us to love others without counting the cost. When we are free from hatred, we are able to forgive others as we have been forgiven. As we live in Jesus and he in us, our happiness will attract people to God.

### Udział w mocy Ducha Świętego

Ta niedziela przypada na dwa tygodnie przed Uroczystością Zesłania Ducha Świętego (Pięćdziesiątnicą) i już dzisiejsze czytania wprowadzają nas w głębsze przeżywanie tego wielkiego święta.

Pierwsze czytanie z Dziejów Apostolskich ukazuje nawrócenie Samarytan dzięki głoszeniu Filipa oraz uzdrawianiu chorych. Czynił to mocą Ducha Świętego. To właśnie Duch Święty sprawia, że Jezus jest obecny dziś – nie tylko w sakramentach, ale także poprzez nas, Jego uczniów.

Jezus wiedział, że po swoich ukazaniach się po Zmartwychwstaniu nie będzie już widzialny jako człowiek. Dlatego obiecał uczniom, że pozostanie z nimi w inny sposób – przez Ducha Świętego, który będzie z nimi i w nich. Sakrament bierzmowania, czyli nałożenie rąk (Dz 8,17), przypomina nam, że gdy Bóg mieszka w nas, mamy udział w mocy Ducha Świętego i jesteśmy wezwani, aby tę moc przekazywać dalej w naszym codziennym życiu.

W drugim czytaniu św. Piotr daje nam konkretne wskazówki. Najpierw mówi o naszej nadziei pokładanej w Panu. Ta nadzieja wypływa z wiary w Zmartwychwstanie – Jezus naprawdę zmartwychwstał, a każdy, kto za Nim podąża, ma udział w nowym życiu.

Następnie Piotr zachęca nas do unikania grzechu, abyśmy mogli żyć w wolności od egoizmu i nienawiści. Taka wolność pozwala nam dawać dobry przykład innym. Odrzucając egoizm, uczymy się kochać bezinteresownie. Uwalniając się od nienawiści, potrafimy przebaczać tak, jak nam przebaczone.

Gdy trwamy w Jezusie, a On w nas, nasze życie nabiera prawdziwej radości i pokoju. To właśnie ta radość i pokój stają się świadectwem, które przyciąga innych do Boga i przygotowuje nasze serca na pełnię darów Ducha Świętego w Uroczystości Zesłania Ducha Świętego.

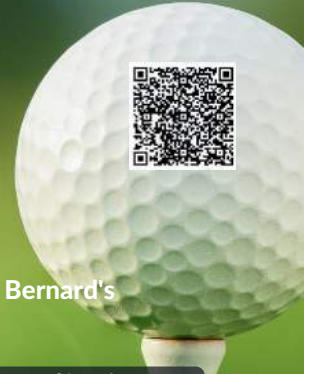

### Food Pantry Update

Thank you to everyone who donated to the food pantry collection for April. We were able to donate 13 bags & 1 box of food.

We collect nonperishable food every first weekend of the month! You can drop off your donations in the Narthex.

The Lockport F.I.S.H. (Friend, I Shall Help) Food Pantry is a 100% volunteer-run organization that ministers to individuals and families facing food insecurity. The pantry is dedicated to serving residents right here in Homer Township, as well as in Lockport Township. They provide emergency food assistance to a diverse community, including low-income households, single parents, senior citizens, disabled veterans, and the working poor.

To provide a dignified experience, they utilize a "Client Choice" model, which empowers clients to shop the aisles and select the specific groceries their families prefer rather than receiving pre-packed boxes.

Obviously demands fluctuates, but the pantry helps approximately 140 to 350 families every month. During times of high need, the pantry has helped up to 800 individuals a month.

## SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



**Baptism:** Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



**Marriage:** The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



**Funerals:** The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home. The funeral home will then contact us at Our Mother of Good Counsel about the upcoming funeral Mass. We will then get in touch with the family to organize the funeral liturgy.



**Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized:** If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



**Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits:** Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



**Religious Education:** We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
