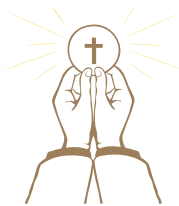

ST. BENEDICT

On July 11th, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Benedict of Nursia. Born in Italy around 480 AD, Benedict sought a life of quiet solitude, but his reputation for holiness quickly attracted followers. He is best known for writing the Rule of St. Benedict, a practical and spiritual guide for community living built on the simple motto of Ora et Labora (Pray and Work). This approach to daily life continues to guide thousands of monastics today.

One of the most notable devotions associated with his life is the Medal of St. Benedict. This powerful sacramental depicts on one side, the saint holding his Holy Rule in one hand and the Cross in the other. The reverse side features the Cross of St. Benedict surrounded by a series of letters representing ancient Latin prayers for protection and peace. Most notably, the letters inscribed around the edge stand for the prayer "Vade retro satana" ("Step back, Satan"), a continuous prayer of spiritual defense against evil.

St. Benedict's reminds us that ordinary daily tasks, when done with a prayerful heart, can become a profound offering to God.

"I'm sitting up straight now!" The baby's oil and sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects her delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. **Zjednoczeni w wierze i wolności – witając wszystkich w
Święto Niepodległości**

Drodzy Parafianie,

W tym roku obchodzimy wyjątkowy jubileusz – 250. rocznicę powstania Stanów Zjednoczonych Ameryki. Z okazji Święta Niepodległości dziękujemy Bogu za dar życia w tym wielkim kraju.

Patrząc na początki historii Stanów Zjednoczonych, pamiętamy, że kraj ten został zbudowany między innymi na fundamencie wolności religijnej. Wielu osadników opuściło swoje ojczyzny i podjęło trud podróży w nieznane, aby znaleźć miejsce, gdzie mogliby swobodnie wyznawać swoją wiarę. To właśnie oni położyli podwaliny pod naród, który chroni prawo każdego człowieka do życia zgodnie ze swoją wiarą – bez lęku i prześladowań.

Nigdy nie powinniśmy uważać tej wolności za coś oczywistego. W naszej parafialnej wspólnotcie są osoby, które dobrze wiedzą, czym jest brak wolności religijnej. Doświadczyły życia w czasach i miejscach, gdzie wiara była prześladowana, a praktykowanie religii odbywało się w ukryciu lub było całkowicie zakazane.

Rozważając dwa i pół wieku historii Ameryki, warto przypomnieć słynne słowa wyrzeźbione u stóp Statuy Wolności:

"Dajcie mi swoich zmęczonych, swoich ubogich, stłoczone tłumy pragnące odetchnąć wolnością."

Słowa te doskonale współbrzmiały z przesłaniem Ewangelii. Jezus mówi:

"Przyjdźcie do Mnie wszyscy, którzy utrudzeni i obciążeni jesteście, a Ja was pokrzepię."

Oba te przesłania zachęcają nas do otwierania naszych drzwi i naszych serc dla wszystkich potrzebujących, bez względu na ich pochodzenie czy życiową sytuację. Przypominają nam o naszym powołaniu do niesienia duchowego schronienia, nadziei i życzliwego przyjęcia każdemu, kto tego szuka.

Kiedy przyjechałem do Stanów Zjednoczonych z Polski i zostałem obywatelem amerykańskim, zrozumiałem, że przyjęcie nowej ojczyzny nie oznacza rezygnacji z własnych korzeni. Jestem dumny zarówno z mojego polskiego dziedzictwa, jak i z życia tutaj, w Ameryce. Nasza parafia jest miejscem, w którym możemy pielęgnować tradycje, które ze sobą przynieśliśmy, a jednocześnie wspólnie tworzyć nowe. W ten sposób szanujemy naszą przeszłość i teraźniejszość, budując prawdziwie zjednoczoną rodzinę wiary.

Niech Bóg pomaga nam nieustannie być wspólnotą otwartą i gościnną, wspierać się nawzajem oraz budować parafię, w której każdy może odnaleźć swój dom w Bożej miłości.

Życzę wszystkim radosnego Święta Niepodległości Stanów Zjednoczonych. Niech Bóg błogosławi Ameryce!

Who Do You Love?

Jesus tells us in today's Gospel that he is "meek and humble of heart." Yet just a few lines before this, he says that he is equal to his Father, the almighty God. So how can the Son of God be both meek and mighty?

Jesus' meekness meant doing the will of God completely. The challenge for us comes in his words "learn from me." We must learn to do God's will as completely as Jesus did.

First, to be complete means that we do all that God wants from us. We cannot pick and choose what we want to do and what we want to ignore. For example, we may reserve the right to decide which teachings of the Church we will follow. But doing God's will completely means doing it without reservation.

Second, we may try to do all that God asks, but give up if something becomes too difficult. We may say we forgive someone, for example, but when they reject that forgiveness, we become even angrier. We can learn from Jesus how to do each part of God's will to completion, as Jesus did all the way to the cross.

Kogo kochasz?

W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Jezus mówi o sobie, że jest "cichy i pokornego serca". A jednak zaledwie kilka wersów wcześniej mówi, że jest równy swojemu Ojcu – wszechmogącemu Bogu. Jak więc Syn Boży może być jednocześnie cichy i wszechmocny?

Cichość Jezusa polegała na całkowitym wypełnianiu woli Boga. Dla nas wyzwaniem są Jego słowa: „Uczcie się ode Mnie.” Mamy uczyć się wypełniać wolę Bożą tak wiernie i całkowicie, jak czynił to Jezus.

Po pierwsze, całkowite wypełnianie woli Bożej oznacza, że staramy się czynić wszystko, czego Bóg od nas oczekuje. Nie możemy wybierać jedynie tego, co nam odpowiada, a pomijać tego, co jest dla nas niewygodne. Czasami wydaje nam się, że sami możemy decydować, których nauk Kościoła będziemy przestrzegać. Tymczasem pełnienie woli Bożej oznacza posłuszeństwo bez zastrzeżeń.

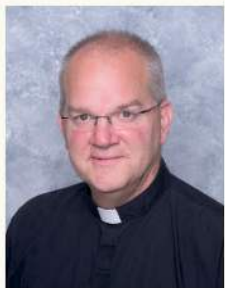
Po drugie, możemy mieć szczere pragnienie wypełniania Bożej woli, ale zniechęcić się, gdy staje się to trudne. Możemy na przykład przebaczyć komuś, lecz gdy ta osoba odrzuci nasze przebaczenie, rodzi się w nas jeszcze większy gniew. Jezus uczy nas wytrwałości – aby każdą część Bożej woli wypełniać do końca, tak jak On uczynił to aż po krzyż.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



Marriage: The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



Funerals: The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home. The funeral home will then contact us at Our Mother of Good Counsel about the upcoming funeral Mass. We will then get in touch with the family to organize the funeral liturgy.



Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized: If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits: Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



Religious Education: We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
