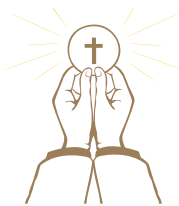

JULY IS DEVOTED TO THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS

The devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus is one of the oldest expressions of the Catholic faith, and it is meant to be a meditation on the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. In Catholic tradition, the blood of Christ is the literal price of human redemption, washing away original sin and opening the gates of heaven.

As St. Peter wrote, we were ransomed "not with perishable things like silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ (1 Peter 1:18-19).

Devotion to the Precious Blood goes hand in hand with devotion to divine mercy. No sin is too great to be forgiven and every drop of Christ's blood was shed out of love for each soul. This observance is rooted to the foot of the Cross and the Last Supper, where Jesus offered the chalice to His disciples, saying, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins" (Matthew 26:28).

Reverence for Christ's blood existed throughout the early Church, but it became a widespread devotion in the 19th century through the efforts of St. Gaspar del Bufalo. Known as the "Apostle of the Precious Blood,"

By turning our hearts to the Precious Blood, we encounter the physical, self-emptying reality of what He endured to save us.



SCHOOL SUPPLY DRIVE

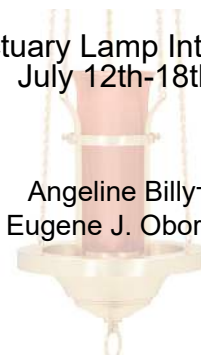

Wydawać owoce w letnim upale

Drodzy Parafianie,

Lato jest już w pełni. Cieszymy się długimi, słonecznymi dniami i czasem spędzaniem z rodziną. Wysokie temperatury przypominają nam jednak, że tak jak nasze ciało potrzebuje wody i odpoczynku, tak również nasza dusza potrzebuje Bożej łaski.

W Ewangelii tej niedzieli Jezus opowiada przypowieść o siewcy. Słowo Boże jest jak ziarno, które pada na różne rodzaje gleby. Tylko to, które trafia na żyzną ziemię, wydaje obfity plon.

Parables

Jesus threw out parables like a farmer sowing seeds. Some of them fell on the ears of those who would be disciples. But most fell on the ears of people not ready to understand. The path, the rocky ground, and the thorns are all metaphors for how his teachings were received. So how do we receive his word?

Do we hear it without understanding, letting it go in one ear and out the other? Do we hear it joyfully, but then forget it when troubles or difficulties come along? Do we listen to the word but ignore it in the face of later temptation?

If we want the word to grow strong in us, we can take steps to help ourselves understand it. We can come to church early and spend a few minutes with the readings before Mass. After Mass we can talk about the readings or the homily with our family over breakfast. We can pick out one practical point to practice that week.

God's word can be likened to a ball game. We can sit back and watch, not really involved or caring who wins. Or we can jump in and participate and make the game ours. Let us ask God how we can take the word and run with it.

Przypowieści

Jezus bardzo często nauczał za pomocą przypowieści. Były one jak ziarno rozsiewane przez siewcę – trafiały do serc wielu ludzi. Jedni przyjmowali Jego słowo z wiarą i otwartym sercem, inni pozostawali obojętni lub nie byli jeszcze gotowi, by je zrozumieć. Droga, grunt skalisty i ciernie są obrazem różnych sposobów, w jakie ludzie przyjmują Boże słowo.

A jak my słuchamy słowa Bożego?

Czy słyszymy je, ale nie staramy się go zrozumieć i szybko o nim zapominamy? Czy przyjmujemy je z radością, lecz w chwilach trudności i doświadczeń tracimy zapał? A może pozwalamy, by troski codziennego życia, pokusy i pośpiech zagłuszyły to, co Bóg chce nam powiedzieć?

Jeśli chcemy, aby Boże słowo przynosiło owoce w naszym życiu, warto podjąć kilka prostych kroków. Możemy przyjść do kościoła kilka minut wcześniej i w ciszy przeczytać czytania przed Mszą Świętą. Po Eucharystii porozmawiamy z rodziną o usłyszanym Słowie Bożym lub o homilii. Wybierzmy jedną myśl z Ewangelii i postarajmy się wprowadzić ją w życie w nadchodzącym tygodniu.

Boże słowo można porównać do wydarzenia sportowego. Możemy być jedynie biernymi widzami, którzy obserwują wszystko z dystansu, albo aktywnie włączyć się do gry. Podobnie jest z Ewangelią – nie wystarczy jej tylko słuchać. Trzeba nią żyć każdego dnia.

Prośmy Boga, aby otwierał nasze serca na Jego słowo i dawał nam odwagę do życia nim na co dzień. Niech zasiane w nas ziarno wiary wzrasta, przynosi obfite owoce i prowadzi nas do coraz głębszej więzi z Chrystusem.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



Marriage: The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



Funerals: The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home. The funeral home will then contact us at Our Mother of Good Counsel about the upcoming funeral Mass. We will then get in touch with the family to organize the funeral liturgy.



Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized: If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits: Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



Religious Education: We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
