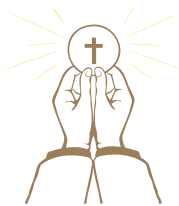

In the Scriptures, St. Peter reminds us that we are "living stones," built into a spiritual house upon Christ, our stone.

As part of our parish's foundation over the past 30 years, looking back to when weekend Masses were held in a junior high gym, our parish took a major step forward on August 29, 1999, when we celebrated our first Mass on our parish grounds under a tent, marking the first

of many picnic anniversary celebrations. That joyful day signaled that our church building was becoming a reality as well.

The cornerstone of our church was blessed on November 19, 2000, and on March 30, 2001, Bishop Imesch formally dedicated our sacred space. What makes our church sanctuary even more special is that Fr. Bob Prevost, O.S.A., the Provincial of the Augustinian Order's Midwestern Province, was present at our dedication ceremony in Spring 2001.

Today, we know him as Pope Leo XIV! Our Holy Father stood in our sanctuary, praying with Fr. Tom Osborne and our founding parishioners as our church was consecrated.

"O you with little faith," trust in the lord as he has given us the strength to be his disciple and carry on his mission by this foundation he granted to us 30 years ago.

Od Namiotu do Świątyni

Drodzy Parafianie,
W Piśmie Świętym św. Piotr przypomina nam, że jesteśmy „żywymi kamieniami”, z których Bóg buduje duchową świątynię opartą na Chrystusie – naszym Kamieniu Węgielnym.

Patrząc na trzydzieści lat historii naszej parafii, wspominamy czasy, gdy niedzielne Msze Święte były sprawowane w sali gimnastycznej pobliskiej szkoły. Ważnym krokiem w rozwoju naszej wspólnoty był dzień 29 sierpnia 1999 roku, kiedy po raz pierwszy odprawiliśmy Mszę Świętą na terenie naszej parafii pod namiotem. Była to pierwsza z wielu rocznicowych uroczystości połączonych z piknikiem parafialnym. Ten radosny dzień był znakiem, że budowa naszego kościoła staje się rzeczywistością.

Kamień węgielny naszej świątyni został poświęcony 19 listopada 2000 roku, a 30 marca 2001 roku biskup Joseph Imesch uroczystie dokonał konsekracji naszego kościoła. Naszą świątynię czyni jeszcze bardziej wyjątkową fakt, że w uroczystości jej poświęcenia uczestniczył ks. Robert (Bob) Prevost, O.S.A., ówczesny prowincjał augustianów Prowincji Środkowo-Zachodniej w Stanach Zjednoczonych.

Dziś znamy go jako papieża Leona XIV! Ojciec Święty modlił się w naszym kościele wraz z ks. Tomem Osborne oraz parafianami założycielami naszej wspólnoty podczas konsekracji tej świątyni. „Ludzie małej wiary” – zaufajmy Panu. To On dał nam siłę, abyśmy byli Jego uczniami i kontynuowali powierzoną nam misję, opierając się na fundamencie, który otrzymaliśmy przed trzydziestu laty.

Przygotowując się do uroczystej Kolacji z okazji 30-lecia naszej parafii, która odbędzie się 24 października Bobek Signature Events w Woodridge, po Mszy Świętej o godz. 16:00, dziękujemy Bogu za wszystkich, którzy poświęcili swój czas, talent i wysiłek, aby wybudować tę świątynię dla przyszłych pokoleń.

19TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Two Steps Forward . . .

Why did Jesus walk on water to the disciples in the boat? Did he want to scare them? No, his first words to them were "Do not be afraid." While they were being tossed by wind and waves, he showed them that he was not affected by the storm. If they had had faith, they might have realized that if Jesus was safe, they would be, too. We too must make that leap of faith, especially when we are afraid.

Our growth in faith is not a steady progression. For every two steps forward, we may take one step back. For example, we become ill or wreck the car, and think that God has abandoned us. But isn't that a natural reaction?

It is natural to doubt God in times of trouble, but we are choosing to live in the supernatural when we become followers of Christ. Like Peter, we can lose our focus on the Lord. We see someone we love who is gravely sick. We make a serious mistake that gets us in trouble. Faith tells us that though apparently invisible, God is more real than anything we can see. Remember Jesus on the cross saying, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" The Father never abandoned his Son and God will never abandon us.

XIX NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Dwa Kroki Naprzód

Dlaczego Jezus przyszedł do uczniów, idąc po wodzie? Czy chciał ich przestraszyć? Oczywiście, że nie. Jego pierwsze słowa brzmiały: „Odważi! Ja jestem, nie bójcie się!” Gdy uczniowie zmagali się z silnym wiatrem i wzburzonymi falami, Jezus pokazał im, że burza nie ma nad Nim żadnej władzy. Gdyby w pełni Mu zaufali, mogliby zrozumieć, że skoro On jest bezpieczny, oni również nie zginą. My także jesteśmy wezwani do takiego skoku wiary, zwłaszcza wtedy, gdy ogarnia nas lęk.

Wzrost naszej wiary nie zawsze przebiega prostą drogą. Często po dwóch krokach naprzód robimy jeden krok wstecz. Zachorujemy, spotka nas wypadek, stracimy coś cennego lub doświadczymy trudności i zaczynamy myśleć, że Bóg nas opuścił. Czy nie jest to jednak całkiem naturalna reakcja?

To naturalne, że w chwilach cierpienia i prób pojawiają się wątpliwości. Jednak jako uczniowie Chrystusa jesteśmy powołani do życia nadprzyrodzonego – do zaufania Bogu nawet wtedy, gdy nie wszystko rozumiemy. Podobnie jak św. Piotr, możemy na chwilę odwrócić wzrok od Jezusa. Widzimy ciężko chorującego bliskiego, popełniamy poważny błąd lub stajemy wobec trudnych doświadczeń. Wiara przypomina nam jednak, że choć Bóg jest niewidzialny dla naszych oczu, jest bardziej rzeczywisty niż wszystko, co możemy zobaczyć.

Przypomnijmy sobie słowa Jezusa wypowiedziane na krzyżu: „Boże mój, Boże mój, czemuś Mnie opuścił?” Ojciec nigdy nie opuścił swojego Syna i nigdy nie opuści również nas. Nawet pośród największych burz życia Bóg pozostaje z nami i prowadzi nas bezpiecznie do celu.

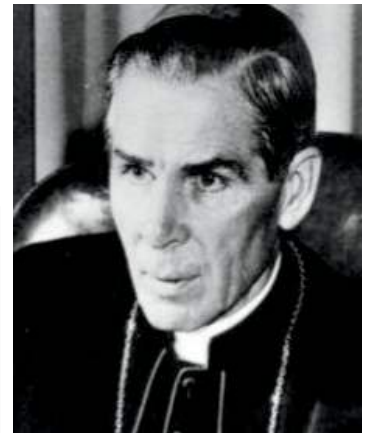

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



Marriage: The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



Funerals: The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home. The funeral home will then contact us at Our Mother of Good Counsel about the upcoming funeral Mass. We will then get in touch with the family to organize the funeral liturgy.



Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized: If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits: Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



Religious Education: We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
